1 Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain; so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.

2 For the idols (a _____ idol) have spoken vanity (to _____ oneself to no avail),

b. The Dangers of False _____ of worship (Zechariah 10:2b) and the diviners (_____) have seen a lie, and have told false dreams; they comfort in vain: therefore they went their way as a flock, **they were troubled**, because there was **no shepherd**.

1) Someone’s in _____ (Zechariah 10:3-5)

3 Mine anger was kindled **against the shepherds**, and I **punished the goats**: for the LORD of hosts hath visited his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle.

4 Out of him came forth the corner, out of him the nail, out of him the battle bow, out of him every oppressor together.

5 And **they shall be as mighty men**, which tread down their enemies in the mire of the streets in the battle: and they shall fight, because **the LORD is with them**, and the riders on horses shall be **confounded**(_____).

6 And **I will strengthen the house of Judah**, and **I will save the house of Joseph**, and **I will bring** them again to place them; for **I have mercy** upon them: and they shall be as though I had not cast them off: for **I am the LORD their God, and will hear them**.

7 And they of **Ephraim shall be like a mighty man**, and their heart shall rejoice as through wine: yea, their children shall see it, and be glad; their heart shall **rejoice in the LORD**.

8 I will **hiss**(_____) for them, and gather them; for **I have redeemed**(release from _____) **them**: and they shall increase as they have increased.

9 And I will **sow**(_____) them among the people: and **they shall remember me** in far countries; and **they shall live with their children**, and turn again.

4) God will _____ what's His (Zechariah 10:10)

10 **I will bring them** again also out of the land of Egypt, and **gather them out of Assyria**; and **I will bring them** into the land of Gilead and Lebanon; and place shall not be found for them.

5) God will destroy the _____ (Zechariah 10:11)

11 And he shall pass through the sea **with affliction**, and shall **smite the waves** in the sea, and all the deeps of the river shall dry up: and **the pride of Assyria shall be brought down**, and the **sceptre of Egypt** shall depart away.

12 And **I will strengthen them in the LORD**; and they shall walk up and down in his name, saith the LORD.
