Zechariah 10:1-12

- 4. The **Prayer** Know Who to ask (Zechariah 10:1-12)
- 1 Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain; so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.
 - a. The Dangers of Idols: Objects of Worship (Zechariah 10:2a)
- 2 For the idols(a family idol) have spoken vanity(to exert oneself to no avail),
- b. The Dangers of False Leaders of worship (Zechariah 10:2b) and the diviners (soothsayers) have seen a lie, and have told false dreams; they comfort in vain: therefore they went their way as a flock, they were troubled, because there was no shepherd.
 - c. God's Reaction to False leaders (Zechariah 10:3-12)
 - 1) Someone's in trouble (Zechariah 10:3-5)
- 3 Mine anger was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for the LORD of hosts hath visited his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle.
- 4 Out of him came forth the corner, out of him the nail, out of him the battle bow, out of him every oppressor together.

5 And they shall be as mighty men, which tread down their enemies in the mire of the streets in the battle: and they shall fight, because the LORD is with them, and the riders on horses shall be confounded(ashamed).

2) Someone's protected (Israel) (Zechariah 10:6-7)

6 And I will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will save the house of Joseph, and I will bring them again to place them; for I have mercy upon them: and they shall be as though I had not cast them off: for I am the LORD their God, and will hear them.

7 And they of **Ephraim shall be like a mighty man**, and their heart shall rejoice as through wine: yea, their children shall see it, and be glad; their heart shall **rejoice in the LORD**.

3) Those in trouble will pay (Zechariah 10:8-9)

8 I will hiss(mock) for them, and gather them; for I have redeemed(release from responsibility) them: and they shall increase as they have increased.

9 And I will **sow(plant)** them among the people: and **they shall remember me** in far countries; and **they shall live with their children**, and turn again.

4) God will gather what's His (Zechariah 10:10)

10 I will bring them again also out of the land of Egypt, and gather them out of Assyria; and I will bring them into the land of Gilead and Lebanon; and place shall not be found for them.

5) God will destroy the enemy (Zechariah 10:11)

11 And he shall pass through the sea with affliction, and shall smite the waves in the sea, and all the deeps of the river shall dry up: and the pride of Assyria shall be brought down, and the sceptre of Egypt shall depart away.

6) God will Strengthen His Own (Zechariah 10:12)

12 And I will strengthen them in the LORD; and they shall walk up and down in his name, saith the LORD.
