

**God's Strategic Plan**  
**Zechariah 12-13**

**Zechariah 12:1-14**

**1. God \_\_\_\_\_ the burden**

1 **The burden of the word of the LORD for Israel**, saith the LORD, which **stretcheth forth** the heavens, and **layeth the foundation** of the earth, and **formeth the spirit of man** within him.

**2. God's \_\_\_\_\_ on Israel - Israel becomes hated by all**

2 Behold, I will make Jerusalem a **cup of trembling** unto all the people round about, when they shall be in the siege both **against Judah and against Jerusalem**.

3 And in that day will I **make Jerusalem a burdensome stone for all people**: all that burden themselves with **it shall be cut in pieces**, though **all the people of the earth be gathered together against it**.

4 In that day, saith the LORD, I will smite every horse with **astonishment**(\_\_\_\_\_), and his rider with **madness**(\_\_\_\_\_; **furiousness**): and I will open mine eyes upon the house of Judah, and **will smite every horse of the people with blindness**.

**Websters 1828: Consternation** = amazement or horror that confounds the faculties, and incapacitates a person for consultation and execution; excessive terror, wonder or surprise.

**3. God \_\_\_\_\_ Israel Home**

5 And the **governors** of Judah shall say in their heart, **The inhabitants of Jerusalem shall be my strength in the LORD of hosts their God**.

6 In that day will I **make the governors** of Judah like an hearth of fire among the wood, and like a torch of fire in a sheaf; and **they shall devour all the people round about**, on the right hand and on the left: and Jerusalem shall be **inhabited again in her own place**, even in Jerusalem.

7 The LORD also shall save the tents of Judah first, that **the glory of the house of David** and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem do not magnify themselves against Judah.

8 In that day shall the LORD **defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem**; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David shall be as God, as the angel of the LORD before them.

9 And it shall come to pass in that day, that **I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem**.

**Isaiah 43:5-6**

**5 Fear not: for I am with thee: I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west;**

**6 I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep not back: bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth;**

**4. God \_\_\_\_\_ Israel**

10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: **and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced**, and they shall **mourn for him**, as one mourneth for **his only son**, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

11 In that day shall there be a **great mourning in Jerusalem**, as the mourning of Hadadrimmon in the valley of Megiddon.

12 And the land shall mourn, **every family apart**; the family of the house of David apart, and their wives apart; the family of the house of Nathan apart, and their wives apart;

13 The family of the house of Levi apart, and their wives apart; the family of Shimei apart, and their wives apart;

14 **All the families that remain**, every family apart, and their wives apart.

### **Zechariah 13:1-9**

#### **5. God \_\_\_\_\_ Israel (Cleaned up)**

1 In that day there shall be **a fountain opened to the house of David** and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem **for sin and for uncleanness**.

2 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, that **I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land**, and they shall no more be remembered: and also **I will cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to pass out of the land**.

#### **6. God \_\_\_\_\_ False prophets**

3 And it shall come to pass, that when any shall yet prophesy, then his father and his mother that begat him shall say unto him, Thou shalt not live; **for thou speakest lies in the name of the LORD**: and his father and his mother that begat him shall thrust him through when he prophesieth.

4 And it shall come to pass in that day, that **the prophets shall be ashamed every one of his vision**, when he hath prophesied; neither shall they wear a rough garment to **deceive(to be \_\_\_\_\_)**:

#### **7. God \_\_\_\_\_ Their Redeemer**

5 But he shall say, **I am no prophet, I am an husbandman**; for man taught me to keep cattle from my youth.

##### **a. He was wounded by His \_\_\_\_\_**

6 And one shall say unto him, **What are these wounds in thine hands?** Then he shall answer, **Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends(have close \_\_\_\_\_ for)**.

##### **b. They were \_\_\_\_\_ by His loss**

7 Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man that is my fellow, saith the LORD of hosts: **smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered**: and I will turn mine hand upon the little ones.

8 And it shall come to pass, that in all the land, saith the LORD, **two parts therein shall be cut off and die**; but **the third** shall be left therein.

##### **c. The \_\_\_\_\_ will follow Him**

9 And I will bring **the third part through the fire**, and will **refine them as silver** is refined, and will **try them** as gold is tried: **they shall call on my name**, and I will hear them: I will say, **It is my people**: and they shall say, **The LORD is my God**.
