**1 Peter 1:13-15**

13 ¶ Wherefore **gird up the loins of your mind**, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in **all manner of conversation**;

16 Because it is written, **Be ye holy; for I am holy.**

- I. **First area we are to be set apart is in our** \_\_\_\_\_  
**Gird up the loins of your mind**

**Ephesians 6:11-12; 14**

11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the **wiles(deceit,** \_\_\_\_\_) of the devil.

**12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.**

a. **Be Sober** (*nephalios nay-fal'-ee-os*)(Not \_\_\_\_\_)

**Titus 2:1-8**

- ¶ But speak thou the things which become **sound doctrine**:
- That the **aged men be sober**, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.
- The aged women likewise, that *they be* in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things;
- That they may **teach the young women to be sober**, to love their husbands, to love their children,
- To be* discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.
- Young men likewise **exhort to be sober minded**.
- In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine *shewing* uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity,
- Sound speech**, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you.

b. **Be Sober** (*nepho nay'-fo*)(be calm and collected in spirit \_\_\_\_\_)

**Paul speaking of the Rapture (II Thess. 4:13-18) is telling us how to behave until it comes**

1 Thessalonians 5:1-8

- ¶ But of the times and the seasons, brethren, ye have no need that I write unto you.
- For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night.
- For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.
- But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief.
- Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.
- ¶ Therefore let us not sleep, as *do* others; but let us **watch and be sober**.
- For they that sleep sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night.
- But let us, who are of the day, **be sober**, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.

c. **Be sober (homophron)** \_\_\_\_\_

**Romans 15:6** That ye may with **one mind** and one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**Philippians 1:27** Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with **one mind** striving together for the faith of the gospel;
