**Proverbs 7**

**I. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Simple (Proverbs 1:1-4)**

**Proverbs 1:1-4**

1 The proverbs of Solomon the son of David, king of Israel.

2 To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding;

3 To **receive the instruction of wisdom**, justice, and judgment, and equity;

4 To give **subtilty (craftiness, \_\_\_\_\_)** to the **simple**, to the young man **knowledge and discretion(\_\_\_\_\_)**.

**II. The \_\_\_\_\_ on the Simple (Proverbs 7:6-27)**

**A. The Simple Ones (Simple = \_\_\_\_\_)**

**Proverbs 7**

6 ¶ For at the window of my house I looked through my casement,

7 And beheld among the **simple ones**, I discerned among the youths, a **young man void(\_\_\_\_\_)** of understanding,

8 Passing through the street near her corner; and he went the way to her house,

9 In the twilight, in the evening, in the black and dark night:

**B. The Foolish Attack**

10 And, behold, there met him a woman with **the attire (\_\_\_\_\_)** of an harlot,

**1. She dresses to attract the \_\_\_\_\_ attention (vs. 10a)**

and **subtil (\_\_\_\_\_)** of heart.

11 (She is **loud and stubborn**;

her feet abide not in her house:

12 Now is she without, now in the streets, and lieth in wait at every corner.)

13 So she caught him, and **kissed him**, and with an **impudent (\_\_\_\_\_)** face said unto him,

**5. She caught him (vs. 13)**

14 I have peace offerings with me; this day have I payed my vows.

15 Therefore came I forth to meet thee, diligently to seek thy face, and I have found thee.

- 16 I have decked my bed with coverings of tapestry, with carved works, with fine linen of Egypt.  
17 I have perfumed my bed with myrrh, aloes, and cinnamon.

d. \_\_\_\_\_ Promises

- 18 Come, let us take our fill of love until the morning: let us solace ourselves with loves.

e. **Outright** \_\_\_\_\_

- 19 For the goodman is not at home, he is gone a long journey:  
20 He hath taken a bag of money with him, and will come home at the day appointed.  
21 With her much fair speech **she caused him to yield**, with the **flattering of her lips** she forced him.  
22 He goeth after her straightway, as an ox goeth to the slaughter, or as a fool to the correction of the stocks;  
23 Till a dart strike through his liver; as a bird hasteth to the snare, and knoweth not that **it is for his life**.

**IT'S A \_\_\_\_\_ SENTENCE!**

- 24 ¶ Hearken unto me now therefore, **O ye children**, and attend to the words of my mouth.  
25 Let **not thine heart decline to her ways**, go not astray in her paths.  
26 For she hath cast down many wounded: yea, many strong men have been slain by her.  
27 **Her house is the way to hell, going down to the chambers of death.**

**III. Proverbs Answer for the Simple to \_\_\_\_\_ sin! (Proverbs 7:1-5)**

- 1 ¶ My son, keep my words, and lay up my commandments with thee.  
2 Keep my commandments, and live; and **my law** as the apple of thine eye.  
3 Bind them upon thy fingers, write them upon **the table of thine heart**.  
A. Keep my words (vs. 1a)  
B. Lay up my commandments with thee. (vs. 1b)  
C. Keep my commandments, and live; (vs. 2a)  
D. **Keep my law** as the apple of thine eye. (vs. 2b) – \_\_\_\_\_ of Focus  
E. **Bind** them upon thy fingers (vs. 3a) – \_\_\_\_\_ yourself what they say!  
F. **Write** them upon **the table of thine heart**. (vs. 3b)

**Psalm 119:11 Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.**

- 4 Say unto wisdom, Thou art **my sister**; and call understanding thy **kinswoman**:  
5 That they may keep thee from the strange woman, from the stranger which flattereth with her words.
