- a. The _____

Revelation 20:1-15

1 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having **the key of the bottomless pit** and a great chain in his hand.

Revelation 11:7

7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that **ascendeth out of the bottomless pit** shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

Revelation 9:1-2

1 And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given **the key of the bottomless pit**.

2 And **he opened the bottomless pit**; and there arose a **smoke out of the pit**, as the smoke of a great furnace; and **the sun and the air were darkened** by reason of the smoke of the pit.

3 And there came out of the smoke **locusts upon the earth**: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.

4 And it was commanded them that they should not **hurt** the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; **but only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads**.

5 And to them it was given that they should not kill them, but that **they should be tormented five months**: and their torment *was* as the torment of a scorpion, when he striketh a man.

Revelation 1:18 *I am* he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have **the keys of hell and of death**.

b. The Devil is _____ from the earth

2 And he laid hold on the dragon (drakōn - _____), that old (_____) serpent (_____), which is the Devil (transducer; Webster's = a device that is actuated by power from _____ and supplies power usually in another form to _____), and Satan (_____), and bound him a thousand years,

3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

Revelation 12:7-9

7 And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels,

8 And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven.

9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

2. Saints of the Great Tribulation _____ 1000 Years (Revelation 20:4-6)

a. The Tribulation _____

4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

Revelation 6:9

9 And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:

Daniel 7:9 I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire.

Matthew 19:27-28

27 Then answered Peter and said unto him, Behold, we have forsaken all, and followed thee; what shall we have therefore?

28 And Jesus said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That ye which have followed me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the throne of his glory, ye also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

3. Satan Loosed After 1000 Years (Revelation 20:7–9) The _____ _____ of Satan

7 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,
8 And shall go out to **deceive the nations** which are in the four quarters of the earth,
**Gog(symbolic name for the _____) and
Magog(_____ party), to gather them together to battle:** the
number of whom *is* as **the sand of the sea.**
9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed **the camp of the saints about,**
and the beloved city: and **fire came down from God out of heaven,** and devoured them.

Ezekiel 38:1-9

1 And the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,
2 **Son of man(_____), set thy face against Gog, the land
of Magog,** the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal, and prophesy against him,
3 And say, Thus saith the Lord **GOD(yeh-ho-vee' = _____);**
Behold, **I am against thee, O Gog,** the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal:
4 And I will turn thee back, and put hooks into thy jaws, and I will bring thee forth, and
all thine army, horses and horsemen, all of them clothed with all sorts of *armour, even a*
great company *with* bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords:
5 Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya with them; all of them with shield and helmet:
6 Gomer, and all his bands; the house of Togarmah of the north quarters, and all his
bands: *and* many people with thee.
7 Be thou prepared, and prepare for thyself, thou, and all thy company that are assembled
unto thee, and be thou a guard unto them.
8 **After many days** thou shalt be visited: **in the latter years** thou shalt come into the
land *that is* brought back from the sword, *and is* gathered out of many people, against the
mountains of Israel, **which have been always waste:** but it is brought forth out of the
nations, and they shall dwell safely all of them.

9 Thou shalt ascend and come like a storm, thou shalt be like a cloud to cover the land, thou, and all thy bands, **and many people with thee.**

4. Satan Cast into _____ and Brimstone (Revelation 20:10)

10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where **the beast and the false prophet** *are*, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Revelation 19:19-21

19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and **their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse**(_____), and against his army.

20 And **the beast** was taken, and with him **the false prophet** that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that **had received the mark of the beast**, and them that **worshipped his image**. These **both were cast alive** into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which *sword* proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

Matthew 25:41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

Matthew 8:5-13 - Jesus with the _____

5 And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him,

6 And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.

7 And Jesus saith unto him, **I will come and heal him.**

8 The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

9 For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this *man*, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth *it*.

10 When Jesus heard *it*, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, **Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.**

11 And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven.

12 **But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.**

13 And Jesus said unto the centurion, **Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee.** And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.

5. Setting of Great _____ - The
_____ Are Judged (Revelation 20:11–15)

a. The _____ White Throne

11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

Revelation 6:12-17

12 And I beheld when he had opened **the sixth seal**, and, lo, there was a **great earthquake**; and **the sun became black** as sackcloth of hair, and **the moon became as blood**;

13 And **the stars of heaven fell unto the earth**, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a **mighty wind**.

14 And **the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together**; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, **hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains**;

16 And said to the mountains and rocks, **Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne**, and from **the wrath of the Lamb**:

17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and **who shall be able to stand?**

Psalms 1:4-6

4 The ungodly *are* not so: but *are* like the chaff which the wind driveth away.

5 Therefore the ungodly **shall not stand in the judgment**, nor sinners in **the congregation of the righteous**.

6 For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but **THE WAY OF THE UNGODLY SHALL PERISH**.

b. The _____ Before God

12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God;

Romans 2:1-16

1 Therefore **thou art inexcusable, O man**, whosoever thou art that **JUDGE**: for wherein thou judgest another, thou **condemnest thyself**; for thou that judgest doest the same things.

2 But we are sure that the judgment of God is according **to truth against them which commit such things**.

3 And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God?

4 Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that **the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance?**

I then realize that I cannot keep the law so _____ by

5 But after **thy hardness and impenitent**(_____) **heart**
treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous
judgment of God;

6 Who will render to every man according to **his deeds**:

7 To them who by patient continuance in well doing seek for glory and honour and
immortality, eternal life:

8 But unto them that are contentious, and **do not obey the truth**, but obey
unrighteousness, indignation and wrath,

9 Tribulation and anguish, upon **every soul of man** that doeth evil, **of the Jew first, and
also of the Gentile**;

10 But glory, honour, and peace, to every man that worketh good, to the Jew first, and
also to the Gentile:

11 For there is **no respect of persons**(_____) with God.

12 For as many as have sinned without law shall also perish without law: and as many as
have sinned in the law shall be judged **BY THE LAW**;

13 (For not **the hearers**(_____) of the law *are* just before
God, but **THE DOERS**(_____) of the law shall be
justified(to render _____).

14 For when **the Gentiles**, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in
the law, these, having not the law, are a law unto themselves:

15 Which shew the work of **the law written in their hearts**, their conscience also
bearing witness, and *their* thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one
another;)

16 In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men **by Jesus Christ according to my
gospel**.

12b and **the books** were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book of life*: and **the dead** were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

Revelation 3:4-5 (record of _____)

4 Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with me in white: for they are worthy.

5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of **the book of life**, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

- **The _____ Book of life**

Revelation 13:8 (book of _____)

8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in **the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world**.

Daniel 7:10 A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and **the books were opened**.

c. The way the _____ are judged

13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and **they were judged every man according to their works**.

14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is **the second death**.

Hosea 13:14 I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be thy plagues; O grave, I will be thy destruction: **repentance shall be hid from mine eyes**.

Hosea 13:4 Yet I *am* the LORD thy God from the land of Egypt, and thou shalt know no god but me: for ***there is no saviour beside me***.

15 And whosoever was **NOT FOUND** written in **the book of life** was **cast into the lake of fire**.

Revelation 13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in **the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world**.

Revelation 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had **received the mark of the beast**, and them that **worshipped his image**. These both were cast alive into **a lake of fire burning with brimstone**.

E. Entrance Into Eternity; Eternity Unveiled (Revelation 21–22)

1. New Heaven, New Earth, New Jerusalem (Revelation 21:1–2)

Revelation 21:1-27

1 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.

2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

2. New Era (Revelation 21:3–8)

3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God *is* with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, *and be* their God.

4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

5 And he that sat upon the throne said, **Behold, I make all things new.** And he said unto me, **Write: for these words are true and faithful.**

6 And he said unto me, **It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.**

7 **He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.**

8 **But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.**

3. New Jerusalem, Description of the Eternal Abode of the Bride (Revelation 21:9–21)

9 And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife.

10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

11 Having the glory of God: and her light *was* like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

12 And had a wall great and high, *and* had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are *the names* of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel:

13 On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates.

14 And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

15 And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof.

16 And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal.

17 And he measured the wall thereof, an hundred *and forty and four* cubits, *according to* the measure of a man, that is, of the angel.

18 And the building of the wall of it was *of* jasper: and the city *was* pure gold, like unto clear glass.

19 And the foundations of the wall of the city *were* garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation *was* jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, a chalcedony; the fourth, an emerald;

20 The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.

21 And the twelve gates *were* twelve pearls; every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city *was* pure gold, as it were transparent glass.

4. New Relationship—God Dwelling with Man (Revelation 21:22–23)

22 And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.

23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb *is* the light thereof.

5. Life on The New Earth (Revelation 21:24–27)

24 And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.

25 And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there.

26 And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it.

27 And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither *whatsoever* worketh abomination, or *maketh* a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.

6. River of Water of Life and Tree of Life, Revelation 22:1–5

Revelation 22:1-21

1 And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.

2 In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, *was there* the tree of life, which bare twelve *manner* offruits, *and* yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree *were* for the healing of the nations.

3 And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him:

4 And they shall see his face; and his name *shall be* in their foreheads.

5 And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever.

7. Promise of Return of Christ, Revelation 22:6–16 HE'S COMING!

6 And he said unto me, These sayings *are* faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done.

7 *Behold, I come quickly: blessed is he that keepeth the sayings of the prophecy of this book.*

8 And I John saw these things, and heard *them*. And when I had heard and seen, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which shewed me these things.

9 Then saith he unto me, See *thou do it* not: for I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God.

10 And he saith unto me, Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book: for the time is at hand.

11 He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still.

12 *And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.*

13 *I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.*

14 Blessed *are* they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

15 For without *are* dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.

16 *I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star.*

8. Final Invitation and Warning (Revelation 22:17–19)

17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

18 For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book:

19 And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and *from* the things which are written in this book.

9. Final Promise and Prayer (Revelation 22:20–21)

20 He which testifieth these things saith, **Surely I come quickly.** Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.
