(1) Announcement of the _____ of Babylon (Revelation 18:1–8)

Revelation 18:1-24 - A Further _____

1 And **after these things** I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power;

Revelation 14:6-10

6 And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having **the everlasting gospel to preach** unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people,

7 Saying with a loud voice, **Fear God, and give glory to him;** for **THE HOUR** of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

8 And there followed another angel, saying, **Babylon is fallen, is fallen**, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication.

9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive *his* mark in his forehead, or in his hand,

10 **The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God**, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with **fire and brimstone** in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

Revelation 14:18

18 And **another angel** came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

1b and the **earth was lightened**(to _____ or send rays) **with his glory**.

Ezekiel 43:2 And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east: and his voice *was* like a noise of many waters: and **the earth shined with his glory**.

The _____ of Babylon has Fallen

2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice,

saying, **Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.**

Jeremiah 51:37-40

37 And **Babylon shall become heaps**, a dwellingplace for dragons, an astonishment, and an hissing, without an inhabitant.

38 They shall roar together like lions: they shall yell as lions' whelps.

39 In their heat I will make their feasts, and I will make them drunken, that they may rejoice, and sleep a perpetual sleep, and not wake, saith the LORD.

40 I will bring them **down like lambs to the slaughter**, like rams with he goats.

Revelation 17:4-6

4 And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:

5 And upon her forehead *was* a name written, **MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.**

6 And I saw the woman drunken with **the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus**: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration.

Isaiah 13:19-22

19 And Babylon, the glory of kingdoms, the beauty of the Chaldees' excellency, shall be as when God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah.

20 It shall **never be inhabited**, neither shall it **be dwelt in from generation to generation**: neither shall the Arabian pitch tent there; neither shall the shepherds make their fold there.

21 But **wild beasts of the desert** shall lie there; and their houses shall be full of doleful creatures; and owls shall dwell there, and satyrs shall dance there.

22 And the **wild beasts** of the islands shall cry in their desolate houses, and dragons in *their* pleasant palaces: and her time *is* near to come, and her days shall not be prolonged.

Revelation 16:12-16

12 And **the sixth angel poured out his vial** upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.

13 And I saw **three unclean spirits like frogs** *come out of the mouth of the dragon*, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

14 For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, *which* go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

15 **Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.**

16 And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue **Armageddon.**

3 For all nations have **drunk of the wine** of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth **have committed fornication with her**, and **the merchants of the earth** are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.

Revelation 14:8 And there followed another angel, saying, **Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city**, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of **her fornication.**

4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, **Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins**, and that ye receive not of **her plagues**.

5 For **her sins** have reached unto heaven, and **God hath remembered her iniquities**.

Genesis 18:20 And the LORD said, Because **the cry** of Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because **their sin is very grievous**;

Revelation 16:19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon **came in remembrance before God**, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.

7 How much **she hath glorified herself**, and **lived deliciously**, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she saith in her heart, **I sit a queen**, and am no widow, and **shall see no sorrow**.

Isaiah 47:5

5 Sit thou silent, and get thee into darkness, O daughter of **the Chaldeans**: for thou shalt no more be called, **The lady of kingdoms**.

Revelation 13:1 And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw **a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns**, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.

8 Therefore shall **her plagues** come in **ONE DAY**, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be **utterly burned with fire**: for strong *is* the Lord God who judgeth her.

21 And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, *every stone* about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.

5 Sit thou silent, and get thee into darkness, **O daughter of the Chaldeans**: for thou shalt no more be called, **The lady of kingdoms**.

6 I was wroth with my people, I have polluted mine inheritance, and given them into thine hand: thou didst shew them no mercy; upon the ancient hast thou very heavily laid thy yoke.

7 And thou saidst, **I shall be a lady for ever**: so that thou didst not lay these *things* to thy heart, neither didst remember **the latter end of it**.

8 Therefore hear now this, *thou that art* given to pleasures, that dwellest carelessly, that sayest in thine heart, *I am*, and none else beside me; **I shall not sit as a widow, neither shall I know the loss of children**:

9 But these **two things** shall come to thee **in a moment in ONE DAY**, the loss of **children, and widowhood**: they shall come upon thee in their perfection for the multitude of thy **sorceries**(_____), *and* for the great abundance of thine **enchantments**(_____).

Revelation 17:16 (_____)

16 And the ten horns which thou sawest upon the beast, **these shall hate the whore**, and shall **make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire**.

Isaiah 34:9

9 And the streams thereof shall be turned into pitch, and the dust thereof **into brimstone, and the land thereof shall become burning pitch**.

Jeremiah 50:34 Their **Redeemer is strong**; the LORD of hosts *is* his name: he shall thoroughly plead their cause, that he may give rest to the land, and **disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon**.

Ezekiel 27:30 And shall cause **their voice to be heard against thee**, and shall cry **bitterly**, and shall cast up dust upon their heads, they shall **wallow themselves in the ashes**:

10 Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, **Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come.**

11 And the merchants(_____) of the earth shall weep and mourn over her; for no man buyeth their **merchandise**(_____) any more:

12 The **merchandise** of **gold**, and **silver**, and **precious stones**, and of **pearls**, and **fine linen**, and **purple**, and **silk**, and **scarlet**, and all **thyine wood**, and all manner vessels of **ivory**, and all manner vessels of **most precious wood**, and of **brass**, and **iron**, and **marble**,

Revelation 17:4 And the woman was arrayed in **purple** and **scarlet** colour, and decked with **gold** and **precious stones** and **pearls**, having a **golden cup** in her hand full of **abominations** and filthiness of **her fornication**:

15 The **merchants** of these things, which were **made rich** by her, shall stand afar off for the fear of her torment, **weeping and wailing**,

16 And saying, **Alas, alas, that great city, that was clothed in fine linen**, and purple, and scarlet, and decked with gold, and precious stones, and pearls!

17 For **IN ONE HOUR** so **great riches is come to nought**(_____).

17b And every **shipmaster**, and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off,

18 And **cried**(_____) when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, *What city is like unto this great city!*

19 And they cast dust on their heads, and **cried, weeping and wailing**, saying, Alas, alas, that great city, wherein were **made rich all** that had ships in the sea by reason of her costliness! for in **ONE HOUR** is she made **desolate**(_____).

Ezekiel 27:30 And shall cause their voice to be heard against thee, and **shall cry bitterly**, and shall **cast up dust upon their heads**, they shall wallow themselves **in the ashes**:

Rejoicing in _____

20 Rejoice over her, *thou heaven*, and *ye holy apostles and prophets*; for God hath avenged you on her.

21 And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast *it* into the sea, saying, **Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.**

Jeremiah 51:63-64

63 And it shall be, when thou hast made an end of reading this book, *that* thou shalt bind a stone to it, and **cast it into the midst of Euphrates**:

64 And thou shalt say, **Thus shall Babylon sink**, and shall not rise from the evil that I will bring upon her: and they shall be weary. Thus far *are* the words of Jeremiah.

22 And the voice of **harpers**, and **musicians**, and of **pipers**, and **trumpeters**, shall be heard **no more** at all in thee; and **no craftsman**, of whatsoever craft *he be*, shall be found any more in thee; and the sound of a millstone shall be heard no more at all in thee;
