

## The Trespass Offering Leviticus 5

### I. The five offerings and their pictures (1-7)

#### A. Sweet savor offerings – Pictures the Person of Christ (1-3)

1. Burnt offering - Pictures Christ as our Substitute (1)
2. Meal offering - Pictures Loveliness of Christ (2)
3. Peace offering - Pictures Christ as our Peace (3)

#### B. Non-sweet savor offerings – Pictures the work of Christ on cross (4-5)

1. Sin offering - Pictures sin as our nature (4)
2. \_\_\_\_\_ offering - Sin as something we choose to do (5)

NOTE: “A Trespass is the invasion of the rights of either God or man” - J. Vernon McGee

“Your rights end where my nose begins...”

Everything that we are or do in ourselves is \_\_\_\_\_ in God’s

**Isaiah 64:6** But we are all as an unclean *thing*, and all our righteousnesses *are* as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

We cannot please God through our works because they are \_\_\_\_\_ by sin

**Romans 8:7** Because the carnal(\_\_\_\_\_) mind *is* enmity(**{ἐχθρα}** Echthra - *hostility*; \_\_\_\_\_) against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, **neither** indeed can be.

**Leviticus 5:1-19**

#### a. Introduction:

1) Sins of \_\_\_\_\_ (Something you \_\_\_\_\_ that you should have done.)

1 And if a soul sin, and hear the voice of swearing(\_\_\_\_\_), and *is* a witness, whether he hath seen or known *of it*; if he do not utter *it*, then **he shall bear his iniquity**.

**James 4:17**

17 Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.

-The taking of an \_\_\_\_\_ before the law...Jesus our example told the Truth!

**Matthew 26:63-64**

63 But Jesus held his peace. **And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.**

64 Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see **the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.**

**2) Sins of \_\_\_\_\_ (Something you \_\_\_\_\_!)**

**Whether you realize it**

**2** Or if a soul **touch any unclean thing**, whether *it be* a carcase of an unclean beast, or a carcase of unclean cattle, or the carcase of unclean creeping things, and *if* it be hidden from him; **he also shall be unclean, and guilty.**

**Even if you do not realize it**

**3** Or if he **touch the uncleanness of man**, whatsoever uncleanness *it be* that a man shall be defiled withal, and it be hid from him; **when he knoweth of it, then he shall be guilty.**

**3) Making a \_\_\_\_\_ and not keeping it**

**4** Or if a **soul swear**, pronouncing with *his* lips to do evil, or to do good, whatsoever *it be* that a man shall pronounce with an oath, and it be hid from him; **when he knoweth of it, then he shall be guilty in one of these.**

**b. Fixing the \_\_\_\_\_ - What he can do to repair the damage**

**1) \_\_\_\_\_**

**5** And it shall be, when he shall be guilty in one of these *things*, **that he shall confess that he hath sinned in that thing:**

**I John 1:9**

**9** **If we confess our sins**, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**2) His Trespass Offering \_\_\_\_\_**

**-An Animal for the ones who can afford it(oxen, sheep or goat)**

**6** And he shall bring **his trespass offering** unto the LORD for his sin which he hath sinned, a **female from the flock**, a **lamb** or a kid of the **goats, for a sin offering**; and the priest shall make an **atonement**(\_\_\_\_\_) for him concerning his sin.

**-The \_\_\_\_\_ - the ones who could only afford birds**

7 And if he be not able to bring a lamb, then he shall bring for his trespass, which he hath committed, **two turtledoves**, or **two young pigeons**, unto the LORD; **one for a sin offering**, and the other for a **burnt offering**.

a) Take it to the \_\_\_\_\_ (\_\_\_\_\_)

8 And he shall **bring them unto the priest**,

b) Offer the sin offering part \_\_\_\_\_ (\_\_\_\_\_)

who shall **offer that which is for the sin offering first**, and wring off his head from his neck, but **shall not divide it asunder**:

9 And he shall **sprinkle of the blood** of the sin offering upon the side of the altar; and the rest of the blood shall be wrung out at the bottom of the altar: **it is a sin offering**.

c) The second for a \_\_\_\_\_ (Cover the \_\_\_\_\_)

10 And he shall offer the second **for a burnt offering**, according to the manner: and the priest shall make an **atonement** for him for his sin which he hath sinned, **and it shall be forgiven him**.

- The \_\_\_\_\_

**2 Turtledoves or pigeons**

11 But if he be not able to bring **two turtledoves, or two young pigeons**,

**Fine Flour** (\_\_\_\_\_)

then he that sinned shall bring for his offering **the tenth part of an ephah**(a measurement of \_\_\_\_\_) **of fine flour for a sin offering**;

**c. Conclusion**

1) No \_\_\_\_\_ items

he shall put **no oil** upon it, **neither** shall he put **any frankincense** thereon: for **it is a sin offering**.

2) The \_\_\_\_\_ - The Priest gets a portion as supply for his needs

12 Then shall he bring it to the priest, and **the priest shall take his handful of it**, *even* a memorial thereof, and **burn it on the altar**, according to the offerings made by fire unto the LORD: **it is a sin offering**.

**13** And the priest shall make **an atonement for him as touching his sin** that he hath sinned in one of these, and **it shall be forgiven him**: and *the remnant shall be the priest's, as a meat offering.*

**3)** \_\_\_\_\_ - **Ignorance is no** \_\_\_\_\_

**14** And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

**15** If a soul **commit a trespass, and sin through ignorance**, in the holy things of the LORD; then he **shall** bring for his trespass unto the LORD **a ram without blemish out of the flocks**,

**4) Sin** \_\_\_\_\_

with thy estimation by **shekels of silver**, after the **shekel of the sanctuary**, for a **trespass offering**:

**16** And he shall **make amends for the harm that he hath done in the holy thing**, and shall add **the fifth part** thereto, and give it unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the trespass offering, and **it shall be forgiven him**.

**17** And if **a soul sin**, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the commandments of the LORD; **though he wist it not, yet is he guilty, and shall bear his iniquity**.

**18** And **he shall bring a ram without blemish out of the flock**, with **thy estimation**, for a **trespass offering**, unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his ignorance wherein he erred and wist *it not*, and **it shall be forgiven him**.

**19** It *is* a trespass offering: he hath **certainly**(אָשָׁם אָשָׁם; 'âsham; *aw-sham'*, *aw-shame* }A primitive root; *to be* \_\_\_\_\_) trespassed against the LORD.
