### The Trespass Offering Leviticus 5

- I. The five offerings and their pictures (1-7)
  - A. Sweet savor offerings Pictures the Person of Christ (1-3)
    - 1. Burnt offering Pictures Christ as our Substitute (1)
    - 2. Meal offering Pictures Loveliness of Christ (2)
    - 3. Peace offering Pictures Christ as our Peace (3)
  - B. Non-sweet savor offerings Pictures the work of Christ on cross (4-5)
    - 1. Sin offering Pictures sin as our nature (4)
    - 2. Trespass offering Sin as something we choose to do (5)

**NOTE:** "A Trespass is the invasion of the rights of either God or man" - J. Vernon McGee "Your rights end where my nose begins..."

Abortion is not a right because it does not allow for the rights of the unborn child!

# Everything that we are or do in ourselves is unclean in God's

**Isaiah 64:6** But we are all as an unclean *thing*, and all our righteousnesses *are* as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

We cannot please God through our works because they are tainted by sin Romans 8:7 Because the carnal(fleshly) mind *is* enmity({ἔχθρα} Echthra - *hostility*; *opposition*) against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

# Leviticus 5:1-19

# a. Introduction:

Sins of omission (Something you failed to do that you should have done.)
And if a soul sin, and hear the voice of swearing(curse, cursing), and *is* a witness, whether he hath seen or known *of it*; if he do not utter *it*, then he shall bear his iniquity.

James 4:17 17 Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.

# -The taking of an oath before the law...Jesus our example told the Truth!

# Matthew 26:63-64

63 But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.

64 Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

### 2) Sins of Commission (Something you did!)

### Whether you realize it

2 Or if a soul **touch any unclean thing**, whether *it be* a carcase of an unclean beast, or a carcase of unclean cattle, or the carcase of unclean creeping things, and *if* it be hidden from him; **he also shall be unclean, and guilty**.

### Even if you do not realize it

**3** Or if he **touch the uncleanness of man**, whatsoever uncleanness *it be* that a man shall be defiled withal, and it be hid from him; **when he knoweth** *of it*, **then he shall be guilty.** 

## 3) Making a promise and not keeping it

4 Or if a soul swear, pronouncing with *his* lips to do evil, or to do good, whatsoever *it be* that a man shall pronounce with an oath, and it be hid from him; when he knoweth *of it*, then he shall be guilty in one of these.

# b. Fixing the **Problem** - What he can do to repair the damage

## 1) Confession

**5** And it shall be, when he shall be guilty in one of these *things*, **that he shall confess that he hath sinned in that** *thing***:** 

## I John 1:9

**9 If we confess our sins,** he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

## 2) His Trespass Offering Options

# -An Animal for the ones who can afford it(oxen, sheep or goat)

**6** And he shall bring **his trespass offering** unto the LORD for his sin which he hath sinned, **a female from the flock**, a **lamb** or a kid of the **goats**, **for a sin offering**; and the priest shall make an **atonement**(**appeasement**) for him concerning his sin.

# -The **Poor** - the ones who could only afford birds

7 And if he be not able to bring a lamb, then he shall bring for his trespass, which he hath committed, **two turtledoves**, or **two young pigeons**, unto the LORD; **one for a sin offering**, and the other for a **burnt offering**.

a) Take it to the priest (Admission of guilt)8 And he shall bring them unto the priest,

## b) Offer the sin offering part <mark>first</mark> (cover the Sin)

who shall offer *that* which *is* for the sin offering first, and wring off his head from his neck, but shall not divide *it* asunder:

**9** And he shall **sprinkle of the blood** of the sin offering upon the side of the altar; and the rest of the blood shall be wrung out at the bottom of the altar: **it** *is* **a sin offering**.

## c) The second for a burnt offering (Cover the sin with Christ)

10 And he shall offer the second *for* a burnt offering, according to the manner: and the priest shall make an **atonement** for him for his sin which he hath sinned, **and it shall be forgiven** him.

### - The <mark>Poorer</mark>

### 2 Turtledoves or pigeons

11 But if he be not able to bring two turtledoves, or two young pigeons,

### Fine Flour (beaten)

then he that sinned shall bring for his offering **the tenth part of an ephah(a measurement of grain) of fine flour for a sin offering**;

### c. Conclusion

### 1) No Celebratory items

he shall put **no oil** upon it, **neither** shall he put *any* **frankincense** thereon: for **it** *is* **a sin offering**.

## 2) The Cut - The Priest gets a portion as supply for his needs

12 Then shall he bring it to the priest, and the priest shall take his handful of it, *even* a memorial thereof, and burn *it* on the altar, according to the offerings made by fire unto the LORD: it *is* a sin offering.

13 And the priest shall make an atonement for him as touching his sin that he hath sinned in one of these, and it shall be forgiven him: and *the remnant* shall be the priest's, as a meat offering.

# 3) Callowness - Ignorance is no excuse

14 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

**15** If a soul **commit a trespass, and sin through ignorance**, in the holy things of the LORD; then he **shall** bring for his trespass unto the LORD **a ram without blemish out of the flocks**,

# 4) Sin Costs

with thy estimation by shekels of silver, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for a trespass offering:

16 And he shall make amends for the harm that he hath done in the holy thing, and shall add the fifth part thereto, and give it unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the trespass offering, and it shall be forgiven him.

17 And if a soul sin, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the commandments of the LORD; though he wist *it* not, yet is he guilty, and shall bear his iniquity.

18 And he shall bring a ram without blemish out of the flock, with thy estimation, for a trespass offering, unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his ignorance wherein he erred and wist *it* not, and **it shall be forgiven him**.

19 It is a trespass offering: he hath certainly(אָשָׁם אָשָׁם; 'âsham; aw-sham', aw-shame'}A primitive root; to be guilty) trespassed against the LORD.
