e) A Transition to God's Temple Revealed

i) God's Temple Measured

1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple(**a sacred place**) of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein.

Zechariah 2:1-2

1 I lifted up mine eyes again, and looked, and behold a man with **a measuring line in his hand**.

2 Then said I, Whither goest thou? And he said unto me, **To measure Jerusalem**, to see what is the breadth thereof, and what is the length thereof.

Ezekiel 40:2-4

2 In the visions of God brought he me into the land of Israel, and set me upon a very high mountain, by which was as the frame of a city on the south.

3 And he brought me thither, and, behold, **there was a man**, whose appearance was like the appearance of brass, with **a line of flax in his hand**, and **a measuring reed**; and he stood in the gate.

4 And the man said unto me, Son of man, behold with thine eyes, and hear with thine ears, and set thine heart upon all that I shall shew thee; for to the intent that I might shew them unto thee art thou brought hither: **declare all that thou seest to the house of Israel**.

ii) No Courtyard Needed

2 But **the court which is without the temple leave(eject) out(Why? That's where the sacrifice and cleansing was made - not needed anymore - IT IS FINISHED - JESUS PAID IT ALL!)**, and measure it not; **for it is given unto the Gentiles(sinful Gentiles who remain on the earth)**: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months(**3.5 years**).

I Corinthians 3:16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?

f) God's 2 Witnesses

3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days(**3.5 years according to the Jewish Calendar**), clothed in sackcloth.

Numbers 11:25-29

25 And the LORD came down in a cloud, and spake unto him, and took of the spirit that *was* upon him, and gave *it* unto the seventy elders: and it came to pass, *that*, when the spirit rested upon them, they prophesied, and did not cease.

26 But there remained **two of the men in the camp**, the name of the one *was* Eldad, and the name of the other Medad: and the spirit rested upon them; and they *were* of them

that were written, but went not out unto the tabernacle: and **they prophesied in the camp.**

27 And there ran **a young man, and told Moses**, and said, Eldad and Medad do prophesy in the camp.

28 And **Joshua the son of Nun**, the servant of Moses, *one* of his young men, answered and said, **My lord Moses, forbid(restrict) them.**

29 And Moses said unto him, **Enviest thou for my sake? would God that all the LORD'S people were prophets, and that the LORD would put his spirit upon them!**

i) Olive Trees

4 These are **the two olive trees**, and **the two candlesticks** standing before the God of the earth.

Zechariah 4:1-14

1 And the angel that talked with me came again, and waked me, as a man that is wakened out of his sleep,

2 And said unto me, What seest thou? And I said, I have looked, and behold **a candlestick all of gold**, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven lamps thereon, **and seven pipes(a tube; wick) to the seven lamps**, which are upon the top thereof:

3 And **two olive trees** by it, one upon the right side of the bowl, and the other upon the left side thereof.

4 So I answered and spake to the angel that talked with me, saying, **What are these, my lord?**

5 Then the angel that talked with me answered and said unto me, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my lord.

6 Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, **This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, BUT BY MY SPIRIT, saith the LORD of hosts.**

7 Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it.

8 Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,

9 The hands of **Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house**; his hands shall also finish it; and thou shalt know that the LORD of hosts hath sent me unto you.

10 For **who hath despised the day of small things?** for they shall rejoice, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven; they are the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth.

11 Then answered I, and said unto him, **What are these two olive trees upon the right side of the candlestick and upon the left side thereof?**

12 And I answered again, and said unto him, **What be these two olive branches which through the two golden pipes empty the golden oil out of themselves?**

13 And he answered me and said, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my lord.

14 Then said he, **These are the two anointed ones**, that stand by the Lord of the whole earth.

ii) **Fire Breathing Preachers**

5 And if any man will hurt them, **fire proceedeth out of their mouth**, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must **in this manner** be killed.

iii) **No Rain**

6 These have **power to shut heaven**, that **it rain not** in the days of their prophecy: and have **power over waters to turn them to blood**, and to **smite the earth with all plagues**, as often as they will.

iv) **Killed by the beast of the Bottomless pit**

7 And when they shall have **finished their testimony**(**record or witness**), the **beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them**, and **shall overcome them**, and **kill them**.

Revelation 13:11 - The First Beast

11 And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon.

Revelation 17:8

8 **The beast** that thou sawest was, and is not; and **shall ascend out of the bottomless pit**, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold **the beast** that was, and is not, and yet is.

Revelation 19:20

20 And **the beast** was taken, and with him **the false prophet** that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. **These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.**

v) **They die where He died**

8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, **where also our Lord was crucified.**

II Peter 2:6 And turning **the cities of Sodom and Gomorrha** into ashes condemned *them* with an overthrow, making *them* an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly;

vi) **3 Day Viewing**

9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.

vii) **A worldly party over the Fallen witnesses**

10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

11 And after three days and an half the Spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

viii) **Another "Rapture"**

12 And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, **Come up hither**. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.

g) **A Great Earthquake**

13 And the same hour was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.

SPECIAL NOTE: Woe #2 - The Second Woe ends

14 **THE SECOND WOE** is past; and, behold, **THE THIRD WOE COMETH QUICKLY**.

g. **NOW THE 7TH ANGEL SOUNDS - Another Heavenly View**

1) **Prophetic Announcement**

15 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

Isaiah 27:12-13

12 And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the LORD shall beat off from the channel of the river unto the stream of Egypt, and ye shall be gathered one by one, O ye children of Israel.

13 And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the great trumpet shall be blown, and they shall come which were ready to perish in the land of Assyria, and the outcasts in the land of Egypt, and shall worship the LORD in the holy mount at Jerusalem.

2) **A Party Atmosphere**

16 And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God,

Revelation 5:8 And when he had taken the book, **the four beasts and four *and* twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints.**

3) Perpetual Gratitude

17 Saying, **We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty**, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, **and hast reigned**.

Isaiah 51:9-11

9 Awake, awake, put on strength, O arm of the LORD; awake, as in the ancient days, in the generations of old. ***Art thou not it that hath cut Rahab, and wounded the dragon?***

10 ***Art thou not it which hath dried the sea, the waters of the great deep; that hath made the depths of the sea a way for the ransomed to pass over?***

11 Therefore **the redeemed of the LORD shall return**, and **come with singing unto Zion**; and **everlasting joy *shall be* upon their head**: they shall obtain gladness and joy; *and* sorrow and mourning shall flee away.

4) Punishment Administered

18 And **the nations were angry**, and thy wrath is come, and **the time of the dead**, that they should be judged, and **that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets**, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest **destroy them which destroy the earth**.

Isaiah 2:2-3

2 And it shall come to pass in the last days, ***that the mountain of the LORD'S house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it.***

3 And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and **let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob**; and **he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths**: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

5) Prime view of God's Heavenly Temple

19 And the temple(**shrine**) of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were **lightnings**, and voices, and **thunderings**, and an earthquake, and great hail.
