i) From Heaven (Revelation 10:1a)

1a And I saw another(else that is _____)

mighty(_____) angel come down from heaven,

II Thessalonians 1:5-10

5 Which is a manifest token of the righteous judgment of God, that ye may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which ye also suffer:

6 Seeing it is a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you;

7 And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with **his mighty angels**,

8 In flaming fire **taking vengeance** on them that know not God, **and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ**:

9 Who **shall be punished** with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;

10 When he shall come **to be glorified in his saints**, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day.

ii) Clothed in a _____ (Revelation 10:1b)

1b **clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head**,

Revelation 4:3 And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was **a rainbow round about the throne**, in sight like unto an emerald.

iii) His _____ (Revelation 10:1c)

1c and **his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire**:

Revelation 1:16 And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and **his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength**.

Ezekiel 1:28 As the appearance of **the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain**, so was the appearance of **the brightness round about**. This was the appearance of the likeness of **the glory of the LORD**. And when I saw it, I fell upon my face, and I heard a voice of one that spake.

Matthew 17:2 (_____ Transfiguration)

2 And was **transfigured** before them: and **his face did shine as the sun**, and his raiment was **white as the light**.

Acts 26:13 (_____ on the road to Damascus)

13 At midday, O king, I saw in the way **a light from heaven, above the brightness of the sun, shining** round about me and them which journeyed with me.

b) The Little _____ (Revelation 10:2-4)

2 And he had in his hand **a little book open**: and **he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth**,

Revelation 5:1 And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, **sealed with seven seals**.

Revelation 8:1-2

1 And when **he had opened the seventh seal**, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour.

2 And I saw the **seven angels** which stood before God; and to them were given **seven trumpets**.

i) _____ (**Revelation 10:3**)

3 And **cried with a loud voice**, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, **seven thunders uttered their voices**.

ii) **Voice from Heaven -** _____ (**Revelation 10:4**)

4 And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, **I was about to write**: and I heard a voice **from heaven** saying unto me, **Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.** (_____)

Revelation 1:19 **Write the things** which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter;

Daniel 12:4 But thou, **O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even** to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

c) **The Angel stands on** _____ (**Revelation 10:5-7**)

5 And the angel which I saw **stand upon the sea and upon the earth** lifted up his hand to heaven,

Zechariah 14:1-9 **When Jesus returns to earth**

1 Behold, the day of the LORD cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee.

2 For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

3 Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.

4 **And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.**

5 And ye shall flee to the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and the LORD my God shall come, and all the saints with thee.

6 And it shall come to pass in that day, that the light shall not be clear, nor dark:

7 But it shall be one day which shall be known to the LORD, not day, nor night: but it shall come to pass, that at evening time it shall be light.

8 And it shall be in that day, that living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be.

9 And the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one LORD, and his name one.

1) Swear by _____ (Revelation 10:6)

6 And sware(_____) by him that LIVETH FOR EVER and ever, who CREATED HEAVEN, and the things that therein are, AND THE EARTH, and the things that therein are, AND THE SEA, and the things which are therein, that **THERE SHOULD BE TIME NO LONGER:**

Hebrews 6:13

13 For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself,

2) ANNOUNCEMENT: The _____ and his Trumpet (Revelation 10:7)

7 **But(howbeit...meanwhile back at the Farm)** IN THE DAYS of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery(**a secret**) of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the **PROPHETS**.

Daniel 12:7 And I heard the man clothed in linen, which was **upon the waters of the river**, when he held up his right hand and his left hand unto heaven, and sware by him that liveth for ever that it shall be for a time, times, and an half; and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the holy people, **all these things shall be finished.**

d) John, take and eat the _____ (Revelation 10:8-11)

8 And THE VOICE which I heard from heaven spake unto me again, and said, Go and take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth.

i) Eat but _____

9 And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take it, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.

10 And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.

11 And he said unto me, **THOU MUST PROPHESY AGAIN**(from repetition - tell before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.

REVELATION 11:1-19 TRANSITION TO GOD'S HOLY TEMPLE

1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein.

2 But the court which is without the temple leave(eject) out(Why? That's where the sacrifice and cleansing was made - not needed anymore - IT IS FINISHED - JESUS PAID IT ALL!), and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles(sinful Gentiles who remain on the earth): and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months(3.5 years).

2 Witnesses

3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days(3.5 years according to the Jewish Calendar), clothed in sackcloth.

Olive Trees

4 These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth.

Fire Breathing Preachers

5 And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.

9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.

10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

11 And after three days and an half the Spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

12 And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.

13 And the same hour was there **a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell**, and in the earthquake **were slain of men seven thousand**: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.

14 **THE SECOND WOE** is past; and, behold, **THE THIRD WOE COMETH QUICKLY.**

NOW THE 7TH ANGEL SOUNDS

15 And **the seventh angel sounded**; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

16 And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God,

17 Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

18 And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth.

19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.
