


AFFIDAVIT OF GREG COX

I, Greg Cox, do depose and state under oath the following:

1. I was aware of the death of Yvonne Layne in 1999 due to my friendship with the John McLaughlin family.
2. I had no involvement in the investigation in any way.
3. I did not contact officials involved in the investigation by phone, fax, letter, tip line, or any other source.
4. I was contacted in September, 2010, and was informed that my name and contact information was included in reports of interviews notated by Alliance Police Detectives William Mucklo and Lloyd Sampson. I was credited with speaking to detectives and with giving information concerning Billy Baker and his possible involvement in the murder.
5. I am acquainted with Billy Baker, but did not give any information concerning him or anyone else to Alliance Police Detectives or Officers. At no time did Detectives Mucklo or Sampson, or any other officer or official, come to my house to speak to me concerning Billy Baker or any other person or event concerning the death of Yvonne Layne. Any statement given by any person saying I gave such information is absolutely untrue.
6. In 1999 I had been sober for approximately eight years and was the manager of the 'Canton Dry Times' and the treasurer of 'ARID', both organizations for recovering alcoholics. Any statement given by any person saying I was intoxicated during this time is absolutely untrue. This information is defamatory and directly opposed to the work I was doing in the organizations I was involved with.
