From Jodi:

- Please bring a limited amount of firewood for your Patrol to use for a Saturday night campfire in your campsite. CFR has firewood at various locations within the pines, however, it's all in varying degrees of rotting and burns really fast.
- If your Patrol needs camping equipment or cooking gear for the weekend, please let me know.
- If you need personal camping gear (tents, sleeping bags, ground pads, etc.) please work within your Patrol to find out if anyone has gear for you to borrow, If not, please reach out to me and I will provide it for you.

- Patrols will be camping in the Pines for Weekend #2, all gear will have to be moved using carts – no vehicles will be used to move gear – please plan accordingly.
- We will be providing the following in each campsite
 - Picnic table
 - Fire ring
 - 5 gallon fire bucket.
- All food brought to camp by the Patrols should be stored safely in campsites. The staff can accommodate those with special diets or medicines that need to be refrigerated.
- Ice can be obtained from the Quartermasters (via the kitchen).
- If you need something while at camp please reach out to your Troop Guide or Quartermasters to see if we can help.

- Be prepared to feed 4-6 extra people at lunch
