Our History

Uppertunity was founded in September 2015 as a Community Interest Company. It started off running one therapeutic art group every week, Scribbles, in Douglas Community Centre in the October. This was a trial to see if there was a need.

In May 2016, Uppertunity made the group official and started to offer more groups. From this, Uppertunity has expanded to three therapeutic art groups, a textiles group, outreach art groups, workshops, and a gardening group.

Our Mission and Vision

Uppertunity aims to help individuals of our community to grow and be part of something bigger. Uppertunity is based in Dundee, and offers skills development and social inclusion opportunities for adults who have additional needs.

We feel that everyone has something amazing inside them that wants to shine through. However, sometimes we need the confidence to believe in ourselves. Uppertunity is here to provide opportunities that instil a belief that people can create a better life for themselves. We focus on the individual's strengths and interests, then work with them to create long term independence.

At Uppertunity, we aim to create an environment where every person is valued and the unique qualities they possess as a person is the starting point for bettering themselves and the world around them. We help build confidence and self-assurance for individuals in order for them to feel part of society and have self-determination and motivation, leading to long term self-reliance.

Achievements: Impact of Groups

Not all profits can be counted into monetary value; the real profit we make is in the social impacts being made. Uppertunity is a good example of a grass rooted social-economy organisation successfully maintaining financial sustainability and supplying growth and development to our members.

Four of our members who initially came to the groups supported, are now attending the groups unsupported. We have also found that since accessing our services, some of our members are now accessing other services.

The groups have helped members become more confident in themselves, and we have seen so many venture out of their comfort zones and test new waters. Some members are even helping other members when they see they are struggling.

Uppertunity has even given some the opportunity to be able to feel part of their community again.

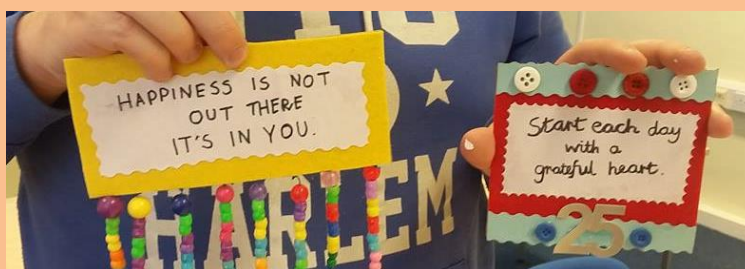


Achievements: New Audiences

Uppertunity has not only grown to build a client base of over 40 members, but we have also made our services available to groups who would not be able to normally access them.

We recently started working alongside Dundee and Angus College, as well as other local organisations such as Scottish Autism, to make sure that adults with additional needs access services to build autonomy.





Achievements: New ‘Uppertunities’ Available

Since establishing, Uppertunity has continued to make sure that there are constant opportunities for individual and community development.

One of these ways was obtaining a plot of land to grow fruit, vegetables, herbs and flowers. This offers a voluntary opportunity, skills development, and the food grown will be used in our up and coming cooking class.

We have recently started to offer workshops and events which introduce new skills and interests. These include 3D printing, spray painting, craft fairs, space observation and many more.

Our Volunteers and Staff

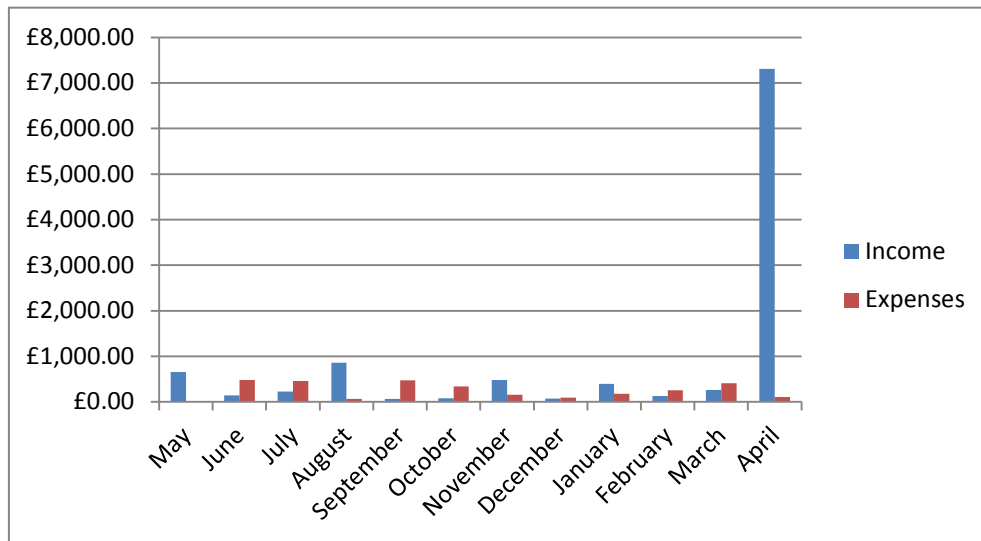
