The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Alaska and Working Group Dog Club of Alaska is now gearing up for our annual Eye Cerf Clinic with Dr. Paul Scherlie on 8-9 2020 February. Saturday, 8 February will be in Wasilla, PUPS (same location as Dianas, Lindsey Dowling is our host) and Sunday, 9 Feb will be in Anchorage at The Pet Stop. Attached are sheets which explains the rates and then the form to list your dog(s). If you need to get directions please let me or Annie know so we can get them to you. If you have received this more than once we apologize as we try and weed out duplicates, but it is getting better, just please understand and thank you for your understanding.

You can use Credit Cards if you go through Pay Pal! You will need to go to: www.WGDCA.org and follow the link. You will find a drop down menu for number of dogs with the fee. If using Pay Pal, You will still have to send your registration form either through email via a scan or jpg or regular mail. This is so we can have your contact information along with your preferred time slot. If this form is not received, we cannot put you on the schedule, so please send. We will respond to you upon receipt.

We want to be able to accommodate your schedule, so if you put in your preferred time slot for your location, it will help for scheduling. Now if you don't put in a time then we will schedule accordingly and let you know.

One thing to keep in mind, we cannot guarantee your time slot if we have not received payment, so once payment is made and you send in your form and we will acknowledge receipt and your time slot for you. All payments either by Credit Card or other must be received by 8 Feb 2020 or you will have to pay as a walk-in and your time slot may have been changed. So please keep this in mind. If you have not heard from us within a short time of mailing in your form and/or payment please contact us as listed below.
