### **SUMMER ACTIVITIES**

#### **Beach Vocabulary Hunt**

A day at the beach can be transformed into a fun vocabulary-building activity. Create a list of items to find, such as seashells, seaweed, and sandcasties. Children can practice labelling these items and use them in sentences. This activity enhances both vocabulary and sentence structure.

#### **Picnic Conversations**

Picnics offer a relaxed environment for children to practice conversational skills. Encourage children to talk about their favorite foods, what they enjoy about being outdoors, and any other picnic-related topics. This setting is ideal for working on turn-taking, staying on topic, and asking questions.

#### **Water Play and Descriptions**

Water play activities, such as playing with a sprinkler or at a water tray or washing up bowl, provide opportunities for language development. Encourage children to describe what they are doing, how the water feels, and what happens when they splash. This fosters descriptive language and sensory vocabulary.
