

## **SPRING ACTIVITIES**

Spring Scavenger Hunt! It is time to look for signs of spring! You could make a visual checklist or simply go for a discovery walk together to see what you can find. Start with a discussion about what you might see to introduce spring vocabulary and practice predicting. Talk about all of our different senses and what you might SEE, HEAR, SMELL, and TOUCH during the walk. During the walk, look for signs of spring like flowers sprouting, buds blooming, bugs, nests/eggs, and other baby animals. You could target commenting, sounds, vocabulary and phrases such as 'I see...' Don't forget to retell what you saw after your walk. You could even take pictures during the walk and make a book about the signs of spring!

Egg Hunt.... Easter is fast approaching. Hide eggs around the house and garden and go on an Egg hunt together. You can use prepositions in/on/under/behind when finding or predicting where eggs might be.
