Projects that involve earth disturbance in accordance with a GP activity are required to pay the E&S Review Fee according to the fee schedule in Item "A" above. Entities (municipalities, municipal authorities, county, state and federal governments) that are exempt from paying the Chapter 105 Application Fees are required to pay a \$50 E&S Plan Review Fee, except for WCCD sponsored projects.

The fees are intended to cover a range of services associated with the processing of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) or Erosion and Sediment Control General Permit (ESCGP) applications; their related erosion and sediment control (E&SC) and postconstruction stormwater management (PCSM) plans; and E&SC plans for all other earth disturbance activities for which a district review is required. Services covered include: pre-design and pre-submittal meetings, plan reviews, telephone calls, review comment conferences, pre-construction conferences, site inspections, permit termination, and administrative support. Such services are also covered for projects where no NPDES permit, and only an E&SC plan, is required.
