States and Commonwealths; and their subsidiaries the corporate Counties,

Parishes, etc.; and their subsidiaries the corporate Cities, Towns, Townships, Villages, etc., etc.; and

Whereas none of the aforementioned entities, legal fictions, privately

held corporations own any land nor do they have any jurisdiction

whatsoever (including but not limited to Martial Rule, Martial Law,

Maritime Rule, Maritime Law, Admiralty Rule, Admiralty Law) over any

private property/lands owned by indigenous people and Whereas the Floridae Province, Empire Washitaw de Dugdamoundyah (which

includes the "area" mis-known and fraudulently misrepresented as

"Florida") is and has been for 11,500 plus years been the wholly owned

land/private property of the hereditary Empresses of the Washitaw de

Dugdahmoundyah Empire; and

Whereas the foreign privately owned corporate United States and its

corporate subsidiaries are illegally and unLawfully operating on lands/private property owned by Her Emperial Highness, the Empress of

the Emperial Washitaw Nation and within the borders of the Empire

Washitaw de Dugdahmoundyah in direct violation of their own corporate

regulations a/k/a "statutes" and "laws;" and

Whereas the same corporate United States and its corporate subsidiaries are operating without the fifty (50) square miles as established as the boundaries of their original 13 colonies (the lands

Every indigenous individual has the right to a nationality.

Indigenous peoples have the collective and individual right not to be

subjected to ethnocide and cultural genocide, including prevention of

and redress for;

(a) Any action which has the aim or effect of depriving them of their

integrity as a distinct peoples, or of their cultural values or ethnic

identities:

(b) Any action which has the aim or effect of dispossessing them of

their lands, territories or resources;

(c) Any form of population transfer which has the aim or effect of

violating or undermining any of their rights;

(d) Any form of assimilation or integration by other measures;

(e) Any form of propaganda directed against them.

Page 5/Articles II(c); PART III, Article 12; Article 13 ArtII(c) Force indigenous individuals to abandon their lands, territories or means of subsistence, or relocate them in special centers for military purposes.

Art. 12: Indigenous peoples have the right to practice and revitalize

their cultural traditions and customs. This includes the right to maintain, protect and develop the past, present and future manifestations of their cultures, such as archeological and historical

sites, artifacts, designs, ceremonies, technologies and visual and performing arts and literature, as well as the right to the restitution

of cultural, intellectual, religious and spiritual property taken without their free and informed consent or in violation of their laws

and customs.

Art. 13: Indigenous peoples have the right to manifest, practice, develop and teach their spiritual and religious traditions, customs and

ceremonies; the right to maintain, protect and have access in privacy to

their religious and cultural sites; the right to the use and control of

ceremonial objects; and the right to the repatriation of human remains.

States shall take effective measures, in conjunction with the indigenous peoples concerned to ensure that indigenous sacred places,

including burial sites, be preserved, respected and protected.

Page 6/PART IV; Article 15, 1st and 2nd paras; Article 16, first para;

Article 17, 2nd para:

Art 15: Indigenous children have the right to all levels and forms of

education of the state. All indigenous peoples also have this right and

the right to establish and control their educational systems and institutions providing education in their own languages, in a manner

appropriate to their cultural methods of teaching and learning. Indigenous children living outside their communities have the right to

be provided access to education and public information.

Art. 16: Indigenous peoples have the right to have the dignity and

diversity of their cultures, traditions, histories and aspirations appropriately reflected in all forms of education and public information.

Art.17: States shall take effective measures to ensure that State-owned

media duly reflect indigenous cultural diversity. Page 9/PART VI, Article 29, para 1: Article 30.

Art. 29: Indigenous peoples are entitled to the recognition of the full

ownership, control and protection of their cultural and intellectual

property.

Art 30: Indigenous peoples have the right to determine and develop

priorities and strategies for the development or use of their lands.

territories and other resources, including the right to require that states obtain their free and informed consent prior to the approval of

any project affecting their lands, territories or other resources, particularly in connections with the development, utilization or exploitation of mineral, water or other resources. Pursuant to agreement with the indigenous peoples concerned, just and fair compensation shall be provided for any such activities and measures

taken to mitigate adverse environmental, economic, social, cultural or spiritual impact.

Page 10, PART VII, Article 35.

Art 35: Indigenous peoples, in particular those divided by international

borders, have the right to maintain and develop contacts, relations and

cooperation including activities for spiritual, cultural, political, economic and social purposes, with other peoples across borders.

States shall take effective measures to ensure the exercise and implementation of this right.
