

Men's League Playoff Format

Playoff Format

- The playoffs will be played as a net matchplay event using an elimination bracket format.
- The teams are no longer flighted. Players are now listed 1–7 based on handicap, with #1 being the lowest handicap on each team.
- Within each group, players will be matched based on their handicap:
 - #1 plays #1
 - #2 plays #2
 - This continues through #7 vs. #7
- The shotgun draw consists of groups of 4 players. Within each group, the players are paired into their matchplay matches.
- For example, in a group of 4:
 - Player 1 vs. Player 2
 - Player 3 vs. Player 4
- If you see “BL” next to your name on the bracket, this means you are playing the other two players in your group.
- Please refer to the simulated bracket on the back of this rules sheet for an illustration of how the playoff format works.

No-Show Rule

- If a player does not show up for their scheduled playoff match, it will result in an automatic win for the opposing player.
- The opposing player will advance to the next round.

Ties

- In the event of a tie in a matchplay playoff match, a manual countback will be used to determine the winner.
- The countback will be completed by the league organizers using the applicable results from the match.

Lower Bracket

- Once a player is eliminated from the main playoff bracket, they will be moved to a lower bracket.
- Players will continue competing in the lower bracket to determine their final finishing position.

- Elimination from the main bracket does not mean the end of the playoffs.

Final Positions

- Players will continue playing through the appropriate bracket until their final position is determined.

Men's League Payouts

- The **top 5 teams in the final Men's League playoff standings will receive a payout.**
- Final team positions will be determined by the playoff bracket results.
- Players should continue competing through their respective brackets, as every finishing position can impact the final team standings and payouts.
