JOINING THE CALIFORNIA NATIVE AMERICAN CANNABIS ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS: [organizing info re Tribe]

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WHEREAS: The California Native American Cannabis Association (“C-NACA”) is an organization of California tribal governments joining together to advocate for the interests of California tribes on cannabis-related issues; and

WHEREAS: The first meeting of C-NACA is planned for September 20, 2017, in Sacramento, California, and the organizers of C-NACA have requested that tribes intending to participate in the first meeting submit tribal council resolutions indicating that the tribal government has approved the tribe’s C-NACA membership; and

WHEREAS: The C-NACA Board of Directors has not yet been established, and membership dues for C-NACA have not been set; and

WHEREAS: By this resolution the Tribe is not committing to pay membership dues and the Tribe may opt out of C-NACA before such time as membership dues are required; and

WHEREAS: The Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interests of the Tribe to join C-NACA as a Tribal Government Member,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Tribal Council hereby approves the membership of _____ Tribe in the California Native American Cannabis Association.
