# 2025 Claw 4 the Cup Official Rules

### 1. Game Rules

- 4 vs 4 format (no goalies)
- Game Length
  - Games are 34 minutes total. (2) 16 minute halves with a 2-minute halftime. Games will be started/stopped by a central horn.
- Goaltending is Prohibited
  - No goaltending by players within a 3-yard radius of the goal which is at the discretion of the referee (i.e., standing in or blocking goal area without actively defending a player or making a play on the ball). A goaltending penalty will result in a free uncontested shot from midfield.
- Slide Tackling & Headers are not permitted.
- Substitutions
  - Unlimited running substitutions
  - Allowed at any time during the course of play (on the fly)
  - Substitutes must enter and exit near midfield and not interfere with active play
- Ball Out of Play Play Restarts
  - Kick-offs will only take place at the start of each half, play will be restarted after goals by a "kick-in" at the endline.
  - Kick-ins used to restart play when ball goes out of bounds

### 2. Scoring & Standings

Win: 3 pointsTie: 1 pointLoss: 0 points

#### Tiebreakers (for bracket seeding):

- Head-to-head result
- 2. Goals against
- 3. Goal differential (max ±5 per game)
- 4. Goals scored
- 5. Coin toss

### 3. Championship Format

- Top teams from each bracket will advance to semifinals and/or finals depending on bracket size
- In case of a tie in knockout rounds, games go directly to a 1v1 sudden-death from midfield. Just like when a game goes to penalty kicks, each team will send out a new player for each round. A 1v1 matchup from midfield will ensue with each player getting an offensive opportunity from midfield against the defensive player. These rounds will be repeated until a winner is determined. A team may not send out the same player until all players have gone.
  - The defensive player is positioned 5-yards away and the play will be started on the referee's whistle.

# 4. Sportsmanship & Conduct

- Referee decisions are final
- Coaches, players, and spectators are expected to maintain respectful behavior at all times. Abusive behavior may result in ejection from the tournament

# 5. Miscellaneous

- Games will be played rain or shine, except in the case of severe weather
- Teams must check in 30 minutes prior to their first game
