

# 8. Continuing Professional Development (SAPC friendly)



'Continuing Professional Development' is defined in the Regulations relating to pharmacy education and training published in terms of the Pharmacy Act, 53 of 1974, as follows: 'Continuing professional development means the process by which natural persons registered with Council continuously enhance their competence throughout their professional careers, and encompasses a range of activities including continuing education and supplementary training'.

A person who is registered in one of the categories prescribed in terms of Section 14 of the Pharmacy Act, 1974, and who is designated as practising on the register, may have their designation changed by Council from practising to non-practising if they do not comply with Council's requirements relating to participation in CPD and the recording thereof in the format approved by Council.

All registered persons who are designated as practising will be required to participate in CPD by following the CPD cycle shown in Figure 1 below. The CPD cycle is a process that involves four steps, namely:

Step 1: Reflection on practice (answers: What do I need to know? and What do I need to be able to do?)

- Step 2: Planning (answers the question: How can I learn?)
- Step 3: Implementation (describes the action taken)
- Step 4: Evaluation or reflection on learning (answers: What have I learnt? and How is it benefitting my practice?).

# 9. CALENDAR (RECORDED & LIVE SCHEDULE) & PRICING

The 2024 calendar and price list are set per quarter. The first quarter (Q1) running from January to March has concurrent specials to look out for. Check our website (www.pharmers.co.za/academy), social media pages (LinkedIn, Instagram, Facebook, YouTube, WhatsApp) for frequent updates, discount codes and more information). Two formats exist for most courses i.e. recorded and live. "RECORDED" means the course is

pre-recorded and available through private links to watch on-demand. "LIVE" means the course is presented in real time with learners (whether online or in person) or both (hybrid). Recorded courses are available monthly. Learners need to register or enrol the month before or earlier to reserve their space for the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month they wish to begin. Live courses are only available according to the calendar or pop-up schedule below. Learners are required to book at least 2 weeks in advance to reserve their limited spaces.

# 10. CONCLUDING REMARKS



Upon completion of any of our courses, participants to the academy will receive certificates. With the full courses, they will also receive a summary of outcome and recommendation letter.

# **Typical Duration**

Recorded masterclasses are taken at your own time and convenience, therefore completion is also dependent on your own pace. The minimum amount of time is 5 days as that will assume one class is taken per day as with the live sessions, but the completion of self study, assessments, homework, and feedback is likely to take longer for most participants. On average a class per week is a reasonable time frame to expect. Many participants have taken on average 3 months to complete the short course 101-104 ext.
