# Drumright Welcomes you!

The City of Drumright Charges an Annual Permit fee of \$100 for all Food Trucks that participate. This needs to be paid prior to the first scheduled event. Please visit the Drumright Police Department, located @ 124 W Broadway, Drumright.

In addition to paying the City Permit Fee, Each Food Truck pays an Electrical Usage Fee each day they come to town.

\$25 – Full Usage....meaning, the Food Truck COOKS ONSITE....grills, fryers etc.

\$15 – Partial Usage.... Meaning the food is pre-cooked and brought in warmers.

These monies are collected DAILY and recorded by a Museum Staff or Volunteer.

## FAQ:

### **How will I know where to set up?**

Please set up as close to Hwy 33 as possible, in the gravel parking lot of the Drumright Museum. The Designated Electrical Outlets are on the East Side of the Red Caboose.

### **What does the fee support?**

The Drumright Historical Society receives the funds to offset the electricity used.

### **How much does it cost?**

\$100 Annual City Permit Fee

\$25 or \$15 per event, based on electrical usage.

### **How many guests typically eat at the Food Trucks?**

Excitedly, many Food Truck Guests “sell out” around 3pm each day...seeing approximately 75 customers a day.

### **What are the Set-Up / Breakdown Times?**

Lunch Hours 11-3

### **What are the Etiquette Rules?**

We have a zero tolerance for bullying. Please be nice at all times....even if you feel flustered.

### **What is the Refund Policy?**

We do not provide refunds.
