Drumright Welcomes you! FIRST Saturday of EVERY Month.... 9am-3pm.

Booths are \$10 (10 x 15) and are available around the Drumright Historical Museum on Broadway and Harley – Drumright Oklahoma. Electricity is available, but very limited (\$5.00 charge/day)...and must be requested in advance.

There is a ONE TIME Application fee of \$15/Season. This will cover The DRUMRIGHT CITY PERMIT and will get YOUR LOGO and Sales Link on the Drumright Monthly Market online presence.

If you are committed to participating all season, we will discount your onetime fee to \$65. This covers all 9 festivals.

Vendors can sell homemade crafts, fresh fruit/veggies, Natural Medicine, baked goods, jellies, plants, small farm animals, and various treasures. Direct sales are also allowed only one per category

*Farm Animals and pets must be caged or on a leash.

Booth reservations may be paid in advance via CashApp \$DrumrightMarket, cash or check made payable to HEART AT WORK, LLC.

Booth payments are not refundable and are available on a first come first served basis.

If you need to cancel, please text ANGELA @ 918-352-8013. This is very important.

Vendor setup & tear down is 1 hour before startup and 1 hour after closed of the day. Each vendor is responsible for their own setup, tent, tables, chairs and extension cords.

Parking

Parking is available on Broadway and on the side streets. Please make sure your vehicles are properly secure with no valuables visible, as Drumright Monthly Market is not responsible for theft or damage.

Rules & Release

1. Arrive on time, stay 'till close, have good attendance. Canopies must always be staked/weighted down.
2. All equipment, garbage or litter must be cleared at the end of each event.
3. Please be respectful of other vendor's space and right to sell their products.
4. Any sales tax, USDA cottage licenses, County Health permits are the responsibility of the vendor.
5. Limited power is available and must be reserved Vendors may bring a generator. If generators are used, they must be quiet, non-smelly, and moved away from booths/people.

Booth Assignments:

1. All tables, canopies, or chairs are the responsibility of the vendor.
2. Reserved spaces may or may not be provided and will be addressed individually.
3. Spaces are first come first serve.
4. The Market Manager reserves the right to move or assign vendors to spaces to improve the overall product placement, layout and function of the Market.
5. Setup may begin as early as 7am the day of the Market but must be complete by 8am.
6. Large Food Trucks are encouraged to arrive early to avoid difficult and tight maneuvering.
7. Refunds will not be granted if there is rain/weather, all booths spaces are full or vendor absence.
8. Applications are accepted March 1st to December 1st .

Liability of Release:

I, the undersigned, agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Drumright Monthly Market their agents or employees from any and all liability for bodily injury or property damage or loss sustained by me, my agents and/or employees as a result of or arising out of the activities conducted or engaged in pursuant to this agreement. I further agree to abide by all rules and regulations pertaining to these events set forth, or any other written or verbal directions from the directors of this event.

By signing this agreement, I agree to follow all rules and guidelines set forth in this document and all other information pertaining to The Drumright Monthly Market. (see above for Market Rules)

How will I know where to set up?

The Friday prior to each festival, the official map will be posted to the Facebook group page: www.facebook.com/groups/drumrightmonthlymarket and will also be added to the corresponding festival link on www.drumrightproject.com

~Also, if you have any questions, a Monthly Market Team Member will be onsite directing anyone that has difficulty.

What does the PROFIT support?

This year, the Drumright Historical Society/ Museum has been selected to receive profits. This community initiative is geared to create an impact that will improve community aspects of Drumright.

How much does it cost to be a vendor?

There are two great options for payment.

Full Season \$65 – Covers Vendor Fee for all 9 Festivals.

Month by Month \$25 - First Month then \$10 Each Future Month.

We prefer CashApp if possible \$drumrightmarket but will also accept cash.

How much does it cost for the public to come to the festival?

This is a FREE Event for the public.

Please help promote the attendance by making or sharing posts on social media.

What are the Set-Up / Breakdown Rules?

We want ALL Vendors completely set-up by 9am. So, if it takes the full hour...please arrive at 8am. Breakdown can begin anytime you are ready, but we hope you stay until 3...most Vendors start to organize and breakdown around 2:30/2:45. You may park real close while loading and unloading....but then please move your car to allow more parking for festival customers. Parking is available on all side streets.

What are the Etiquette Rules?

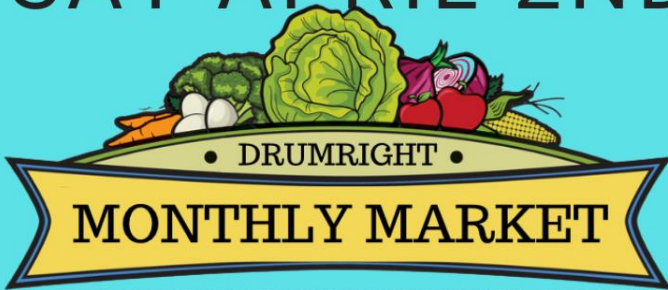
We have a zero tolerance for bullying. Please be nice at all times....even if you feel flustered.
