Iceland Immersion Itinerary

Day 1

Destination: Reykjavik

Meals Included: None

Velkommin! Welcome to Reykjavik – the world's most northerly capital and the starting point of your adventure. You'll be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel. You'll then have a welcome meeting at 6 pm tonight to meet your group and local leader. If you arrive early, maybe take a trip to the National Museum to see the permanent exhibition of Iceland's history.

Special information

It's very important that you attend the welcome meeting as we will be collecting insurance and emergency contact details at this time. If you are going to be late, please let your travel agent or hotel reception know. Ask reception or look for a note in the lobby for more information on where the meeting will take place. If you're interested in visiting the Blue Lagoon at the end of the trip and haven't already booked yourself a slot, it's best to mention this to your local leader at the welcome meeting so they can attempt to arrange tickets.

Day 2

Destination: Reykjavik / Golden Circle

Meals Included: Breakfast

This morning, head to the geologically and historically important Thingvellir National Park. The national park may seem to be just a natural wonder, but your leader will be on hand to provide historical context and explain that this was the original site of Iceland's old parliament from AD 930. Visit the spouting hot springs of Geysir and Strokkur before driving to the spectacular Gullfoss – Iceland's largest waterfall. This afternoon, maybe visit the Secret Lagoon – a natural geothermal pool warmed by the nearby hot springs.

Day 3

Destination: South Coast / Jokulsarlon

Meals Included: Breakfast

Today hike in Skaftafell National Park, where you'll walk through a landscape shaped by glaciers, volcanoes, and centuries of natural forces. Visit Seljalandsfoss, where you can walk close to the waterfall and, when conditions allow, follow the path behind the falling water. Nearby, discover Gljúfrabúi, a hidden waterfall tucked away inside a small canyon. Continue to Skógafoss, a powerful 60-metre waterfall where you can get up close to the spray or climb the steps beside the falls for a different viewpoint. The day continues to Dyrhólaey Peninsula, a great spot to take in wide views over the coastline, black sand beaches, and towering sea cliffs. Finish at Reynisfjara Beach, one of Iceland's most famous beaches, where you can walk along the black volcanic sand, see the impressive basalt columns, and look out towards the Reynisdrangar sea stacks standing offshore. Be sure to stay aware of the ocean here, as the waves can be very powerful.

Day 4

Destination: Jokulsarlon / South Coast / Reykjavik

Meals Included: Breakfast

Today start with a glacier boat ride on Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon. Cruise among floating icebergs that have broken away from the nearby glacier, surrounded by mountain views and the ever-changing Arctic scenery. Nearby, visit Diamond Beach, where pieces of ice from the lagoon wash ashore and sparkle against the black volcanic sand. Continue west to Reykjavik via Fjaðrárgljúfur Canyon, a beautiful winding canyon carved by glacial waters over thousands of years. Follow the walking paths along the canyon's edge, taking in views of the steep moss-covered cliffs, the winding river below, and the peaceful Icelandic landscape.

Day 5

Destination: Borgarfjordur / Snaefellsnes Peninsula

Meals Included: Breakfast, Dinner

After breakfast, head to the remote and geographically fascinating Snaefellsnes Peninsula – your home for the next two nights. On your way visit the Borgarfjordur area, you'll pass waterfalls Hraunfossar and Barnafossar, then continue to Deildartunguhver – Europe's most powerful hot spring. Take a relaxing dip in the Krauma thermal pools, where waters from the hot spring mix with glacial waters to create the perfect temperature. Tonight, have dinner at your accommodation.

Day 6

Destination: Snaefellsnes Peninsula

Meals Included: Breakfast, Dinner

Today, you'll explore the Snaefellsnes Peninsula, beginning with the Snaefellsjokull glacier – an icecap that covers a dormant volcano. Travel to the small fishing village of Arnarstapi, where a short stroll along the coastal cliffs will reveal rich birdlife. Stop by Djupalonssandur – a basaltic pebble beach framed by strange lava formations – then visit the village of Grundarfjordur, famous for its views of Mt Kirkjufell. Visit the iconic Budir Black Church, a small, striking 19th-century church set against the lava fields and mountains of the Snaefellsnes Peninsula. Enjoy another dinner at your accommodation.

Destination: Reykjavik

Today, you'll return to Reykjavik. On the drive, your leader may share some stories of Norse mythology, so keep an eye out for elves and fairies along the way! Head out from Ólafsvík on a whale watching tour along the Snæfellsnes coastline, where you'll cruise through scenic waters with views of mountains and the Snæfellsjökull glacier. Keep an eye out for whales, dolphins, and seabirds, often spotted feeding in these rich fishing grounds. Return back to Reykjavik afterwards. Iceland's capital has an eclectic art and music scene, and this afternoon you may like to browse some of the city's excellent galleries and museums.

Important Information

- Iceland can be an expensive destination in many ways, from museum entrance fees to visiting a cafe, but especially in terms of eating out. To provide you with an example, a main meal outside of Reykjavik can be around the ISK 4,000 mark. Your leader will be able to advise on how to save money. In remote areas the only option for dinner will be at the guesthouse we are staying at. Please stock up on food at a supermarket prior to arrival if you would like to opt out eating at the guesthouses' restaurants.
- Due to the remote locations we visit, there are a few long drives on this trip. This is a great opportunity to enjoy the scenery and spend some time getting to know the other members of your group.
- As accommodation on this trip is twin-share, single travellers will share a room with another traveller of the same gender. If you'd prefer not to share, a single room supplement can be requested at an additional charge. Also, hotels in Europe often don't have double beds, but rather two single beds that can be pushed together/apart. Please also be aware that most guesthouses in Iceland offer shared bathrooms rather than en-suite facilities. Rooms in Iceland can be small, and at times you may be accommodated a short walk away from the main building. This applies to sharing travellers as well as travellers who have booked a single supplement.
