Meet your leader and fellow travellers at a 6 pm welcome meeting and after, maybe head out together for a dinner and get to know your fellow travellers.

Day 2/ Thu 4 Jun 2026 Istanbul Meals included: Breakfast

Today, embark on your adventure to uncover the treasures of Istanbul. Start your day at the Hippodrome of Constantinople, once the social and sporting heart of the Byzantine Empire. Imagine the roar of the crowds during chariot races as you walk among ancient monuments like the Serpent Column and the Obelisk of Theodosius. Next, step into the serene beauty of the Blue Mosque (Sultan Ahmet Camii), one of Istanbul's most iconic landmarks. Marvel at its cascading domes, six elegant minarets, and the interior lined with over 20,000 handmade iznik tiles in shades of blue. Then, follow the aroma of spices and leather to the bustling Grand Bazaar — one of the largest and oldest covered markets in the world. Lose yourself in a maze of over 4,000 shops selling everything from carpets and ceramics to jewelry and sweets. It's a shopper's paradise and a cultural experience rolled into one. Let your guide lead you through hidden backstreets and lesser-known corners of the city. Perhaps you'll pause for a fresh simit and a glass of Turkish tea, or sit down for a strong Turkish coffee paired with flaky, sweet baklava. Today is all about soaking up the local rhythm. Live the city like a local. Finally, see the city from a whole new perspective — from the water. Sail along the majestic Bosphorus Strait, the natural boundary between Europe and Asia and the lifeblood of Istanbul. This scenic cruise offers breathtaking views of opulent Ottoman-era mansions, the dazzling Dolmabahçe Palace, charming shing villages, and the city's three intercontinental bridges. The breeze, the skyline, and the rhythmic sway of the boat combine to give you a magical end to your day.

Day 3 / Fri 5 Jun 2026 Istanbul

Meals included: Breakfast

This morning, after breakfast, step into the grandeur of Topkapi Palace. Perched above the sparkling waters of the Bosphorus, this opulent complex was the heart of the Ottoman Empire between 1453 and 1839. As you wander through its courtyards, pavilions, and ornate chambers, your guide will share colourful tales of the sultans who once called this place home. Next, descend into the mysterious depths of the Basilica Cistern. This underground wonder, supported by hundreds of marble columns, once stored the city's water supply during Byzantine times. It's not only an impressive feat of engineering but also steeped in legend — keep an eye out for the Medusa heads! You'll learn about its crucial role in Istanbul's survival and its transformation over centuries. Your final stop for the day is the magnificent Grand Hagia Sophia Mosque. Prepare to be awestruck by this architectural marvel commissioned by Emperor Justinian the Great. Towering gracefully over the city for more than 1,500 years, Hagia Sophia has served as a church, a mosque, a museum, and now, once again, a mosque. Its grand dome and intricate mosaics speak volumes about the layers of history and culture woven into Istanbul's fabric.

Day 4 / Sat 6 Jun 2026 Cappadocia

Meals included: Breakfast, Dinner

This morning, arrive in Cappadocia after a 1-hour flight. Once you arrive, it may feel as if you landed on another planet. Over millions of years, rain and wind have shaped the soft white volcanic rock of the plain into an otherworldly landscape of dripping cones, pillars, pinnacles, and fairy chimneys soaring more than a hundred feet into the sky. Follow your leader on an orientation walk. Tonight, you'll stay in a cave hotel! Tonight, you'll be warmly welcomed into a local cave home. The family will prepare a special home-cooked dinner for your group. Sit down to a feast made with passion, enjoy a friendly chat with your host and perhaps top off the night with some Turkish delight.

Day 5 / Sun 7 Jun 2026 Cappadocia Meals included: Breakfast

This morning you have the option to take a hot air balloon flight, a once-in-a-lifetime experience to watch on as the sun illuminates the skyline dotted with balloons. Even if you'd prefer not to take a flight, it's still worth waking up for this truly incredible sight. Later in the morning, head out to the Goreme Open Air Museum, a monastic complex and Christian sanctuary of carved houses, churches and monasteries. The museum was one of the earliest centres for religious education and there are at least ten churches and chapels in the complex, dating between AD 900 and 1200. Enter the cave chapels and witness the exquisite colour of the biblical frescoes found within. The Dark Church has a particularly stunning interior, which you may choose to visit at an additional cost. Later this morning, enjoy a scenic walk through the valleys with your leader, featuring fairy chimneys, deserted rock-cut homes and cave churches.Next, you'll visit a carpet weaving cooperative that empowers women by giving them the tools to produce one-of-a-kind traditional rugs. Hear local insight into the history of traditional carpet weaving and see how the intricate pieces are made.

Day 6 / Mon 8 Jun 2026 Cappadocia Meals included: Breakfast

Today start your day with Kaymakli Underground City. There are 36 underground cities in Cappadocia and the widest one is Kaymakli underground city. Kaymakli underground city is built under the hill known as the Citadel of Kaymakli and was opened to visitors in 1964. The people of Kaymakli (Enegup in Greek) village have constructed their houses around nearly one hundred tunnels of the underground city. The inhabitants of the region still use the most convenient places in the tunnels as cellars, storage areas and stables, which they access through their courtyards. The Kaymakli Underground City has low, narrow and sloping passages. While the underground city consists of 8 floors below ground, only 4 of them are open to the public today, in which the spaces are organized around ventilation shafts. Then take a soft valley walk. You can spend your afternoon however you like. Trying the region's famous pottery kebab and attending a Whirling Dervish performance could be a good option.

Day 7 / Tue 9 Jun 2026 Selcuk

Meals included: Breakfast

This morning, catch a flight to Izmir. Occasionally, a connecting flight may be required when direct options aren't available. Upon arrival in Selçuk, join your leader for an orientation walk around the slopes of Ayasoluk Hill, where history surrounds you at every turn. You'll pass the Isa Bey Mosque and the towering Byzantine citadel known as the Grand Fortress. Just below lie the atmospheric ruins of the Basilica of St John, built by Emperor Justinian I in the 6th century. Spend the rest of your day soaking up the charm of Selçuk – mingle with friendly locals, browse quaint shops, and sample delicious regional flavours at your own pace.

Day 8 / Wed 10 Jun 2026 Selcuk

This morning, start the day with a short distance out of Selcuk is one of the ancient world's Seven Wonders – the Temple of Artemis – although, sadly, only a single column (of 127 originally) remains. Then, visit the ruins of the ancient city of Ephesus – one of the best-preserved Greco-Roman classical cities in the world. Once the capital city of Roman Asia Minor, the city has a fascinating history, which really comes alive with a local guide. Considering their age, the ruins are in incredible shape, and it's not difficult to imagine them in their full glory over 2000 years ago, equipped with running water, public toilets, a medical institute and Roman baths. The theatre is well preserved and regularly hosts concerts, but it's perhaps the magnificent library that is the most striking. Then, drive to the nearby village of Sirince to taste locally produced fruit wines. This authentic Greek Ottoman village seems to have been overlooked by modern development and the unique architecture makes for a great photo. When you return to Selcuk, for dinner head to a restaurant run by a local woman and enjoy some local traditional dishes. Hatice started her journey when her husband's business went bankrupt. Until that time, she had been a housewife for 18

years and had never worked outside home. She first started cooking Gozleme on the roadside where her own restaurant is located today and is now a well-known local chef providing opportunities to other local women in the region.

In the evening, take a short ferry ride across the Bosphorus to the vibrant Asian side, arriving in the bustling district of Kadıköy. Kadıköy, meaning "Village of the Judge," was once a separate settlement facing ancient Byzantium. Today, it's one of Istanbul's liveliest neighbourhoods — a cultural hotspot known for its youthful vibe, rich history, local markets, art scene, and countless cafés, pubs, and restaurants by the sea. Wander the colourful streets, pop into boutique shops, and sample local street food favourites as you soak up the local atmosphere. This is a perfect chance to reflect on your journey and wrap up your adventure with your group. Choose a local spot for a memorable farewell dinner with your guide. As night falls, catch the ferry back to the European side and enjoy the magical city lights of Istanbul from the water — a truly special way to end your trip.
