Guests of the 2025 ChaShaMa Gala will encounter five unique installation spaces that combine physical scenery, lighting, sound, live performance, and more to ignite the senses and inspire the curious mind. It is our goal as designers to bring these abstract concepts to vivid life by using our shared experiences in theatre, film, and theme park design to craft an unforgettable evening.

Picture a tranquil meadow where ideas take root and blossom into dreams that manifest into a bountiful garden - you've arrived at The Garden of Your Mind. 




