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1. Generate awareness: Getting the word out about the best job in the world

building awareness with those that might not be thinking about fire service as an option

- 1. Marketing materials inclusive language websites / job postings
- 2. Department branding
- 3. Social media messaging
- 4. Brand ambassadors / recruitment ambassadors

2. Building interest - Career Exploration / What is the job really about?

building interest in those that are interested in exploring fire/ems

- 1. Interactive Open House
- 2. Job/Career Fairs
- 3. Ride Along Experiences

3. Fill your pipeline: create connection; get commitment

build commitment in those that have chosen to pursue this as a career

- 1. Cadet/Explorer Programs High School Programs
- 2. Internship/Apprenticeship Programs

4. Onboarding touch points for new recruits

building community and loyalty to retain employees already hired

- 1. Joint hiring processes or academies to onboard multiple recruits at once builds community
- 2. Involve the family / support network
- 3. State very clear expectations from the beginning
- 4. Create check-in points to give and receive feedback regularly
- 5. Create small milestone wins to keep motivation
