## **2023 YEAR END SERVICES AND PROGRAMS**

### **Pantry**

Our relationship with the Akron Canton Regional Food Bank helps BACM with providing a five-day emergency supply of food provided to clients twice per month. We target families living in Barberton, Norton, Clinton, New Franklin, and Doylestown.

- (a) Meals provided - 656,691
- (b) Food provided – 302,945 lbs.
- (c) Produce 47,147 pounds provided.
- (d) Clients are able to choose the food they take home.
- (e) Clients choose pet food as we have a donor that supplies a contribution for pet food.
- (f) Between January and March, 566 households received Bags of Love.
- (g) Churches and individuals donated 4,956 bags of groceries.

### **Cooking Classes**

The Ohio State University provided the cooking classes in 2023 due to the Pandemic.

### **Other Programs**

- (a) Clients requesting assistance were given information for contacting Catholic Charities and other organizations for needs.
- (b) BACM had 806 households assisted with services through BACM. Helping clients with applications for Medicaid/Medicare, First Energy, SNAP, HEAP, smoke detectors, senior classes at the YMCA, free and reduced lunch programs, Energy Conservation Services (refrigerators, freezers, lights, etc.) They assisted with Living Wills, Healthcare Powers of Attorney, and General Powers of Attorney.
- (c) The Assurance Wireless information was given to clients for obtaining cellular phones.
- (d) Clients have available brochures for agencies for referrals to various programs that are free.
- (e) Provided delivery to 92 low-income seniors who participated in the CFSP program once a month. Total given out was 1,014.
- (f) Clients had access to representatives for employment services and insurance.

- (g) Pet Food Ministry – BACM has one donor who generously sponsors our pet food ministry, and we also receive food from the Norton Pet Supply Plus and the Summit County Humane Society. Pets have food insecurities too.
- (h) Pet Therapy – Past board member Larry Okolish brings golden retriever, Finn, to visit clients on pantry days.
- (i) Home Food Deliveries – Home deliveries are available to clients who are senior (ages 65 and over). BACM served 1,148 with home deliveries.
- (j) Veteran’s Counseling and Benefit Help with Bishop Edmond Fast PH.D, Chaplain with The American Legion 566 and VFW 1066.
- (k) Caption Call information made available to assist hearing impaired clients in receiving visual message phones.
