

BACM Bingo Frequently Asked Questions (updated 2/22/24)

When is BACM Bingo – Wednesday, April 3, 2024

Where is BACM Bingo held – Prince of Peace Church, 1263 Shannon Ave, Barberton

What time can I attend – Doors will not open at 4:30pm

What time is dinner – Dinner is available from 5pm – 6pm. The church has a stove and sterno warming trays to keep food warm.

What is for dinner – We will be ordering dinner from Leach's Meats & Sweets catering, exact meal will be update here were determined.

What is available to drink – Lemonade, ice tea, water and decaf coffee.

What time is bingo – 10 bingo games will begin near 6:15pm

What is the admission cost – Dinner & 10 games of bingo is \$30 per ticket.

When can I purchase a ticket –Friday, February 23, 2024.

How can I purchase a ticket – Presale only tickets are available at www.bacm.org by credit or debit card.

What are the fees involved in purchasing a ticket – Unfortunately, the credit card company charges BACM approximately \$1 fee per \$30 charge. We are asking guests to pay this fee. As a thank you for chipping in the extra dollar, every ticket purchased will be entered into a special drawing.

How can I purchase a ticket if I don't have internet service and/or credit card – If you have email, contact the Fundraising Committee at fundraiser@bacm.org. If no email, call or text Teri at 330-618-9571 to make other arrangements.

How many guests can attend BACM Bingo – Prince of Peace holds a maximum of 200 guests. We will pre-sale as many tickets as possible, with a maximum of 200.

Is anything other than dinner served – Simple dessert, such as brownies and cookies will be on your table. Also, gluten free cookies will be available in the kitchen. During intermission after game 5, individually packaged potato chips will be available near the kitchen.

Will raffle baskets be available – Yes, board members, volunteers and local businesses have donated great raffle baskets.

What will bingo winners win – For games 1 through 9, winners will receive a spring plant and random \$25 gift card. Gift cards are donated, such as Amazon, Walmart, Ace, Circle K and Applebee's. A complete list of gift cards will be listed in the event program. For the grand prize of game 10, the single winner will receive a \$50 restaurant gift card and \$50 movie gift card and large spring plant.

How much are raffle tickets – Raffle tickets are sold by the sheet; large sheets of 25 tickets are \$20 each. Each sheet includes a chance to win a door prize.

What are the door prizes – We don't know yet. All door prizes are donated by the community. In the past, they have included trays of baklava, gift cards, candy, lotion & soaps, etc.

Will you offer a 50/50 drawing – Yes, each ticket is \$1 or 6 for \$5. October's event winner received \$463.

How will you raise funds – Everything, except dinner and hall rental is donated by the community, board members, volunteers and supporters. Admission ticket income, plus raffle ticket and 50/50 ticket sales minus expenses is the total profit.

What will be done with the profits – October's event raised over \$7,200 for the food pantry. The funds raised at this event will support the food pantry also. BACM serves over 3,300 people each month, taking home over 50,000 meals. Food is expensive! We have a separate fund for building renovations and improvements.

What is the minimum age of guests – Guests age 16 & up are welcome to play bingo.
