

BACM Bingo Frequently Asked Questions (updated 9/9/24)

When is BACM Bingo – Wednesday, October 23, 2024

Where is BACM Bingo held – Prince of Peace Church, 1263 Shannon Ave, Barberton

What time can I attend – Doors will open at 4:30pm

What time is dinner – Dinner is available from 5pm – 6pm. The church has a stove and sterno warming trays to keep food warm.

What is for dinner – We will be ordering dinner from Leach's Meats & Sweets catering.
Meal to be determined.

What is available to drink – Lemonade, ice tea, water and decaf coffee.

What time is bingo – 10 bingo games will begin near 6:15pm

What is the admission cost – \$30 per person including dinner & 10 games (3 board per game) of bingo.

When can I purchase a ticket – Fri. Sept 13 – Mon. Oct 21 or until 200 tickets are sold.

How can I purchase a ticket – Presale only tickets are available at www.bacm.org by credit or debit card.

What are the fees involved in purchasing a ticket – We have a new credit card processor, guests can choose to pay the convenient fee or opt out. If you chose to pay the fee, you will be entered into a drawer for a free gift card.

How can I purchase a ticket if I don't have internet service and/or credit card – If you have email, contact the Fundraising Committee at fundraiser@bacm.org. If no email, call or text Teri at 330-618-9571 to make other arrangements.

How many guests can attend BACM Bingo – Prince of Peace holds a maximum of 200 guests. We will pre-sale as many tickets as possible, with a maximum of 200.

Is anything other than dinner served – Simple dessert, such as brownies, cookies and baklava will be on your table. Also, gluten free cookies will be available in the kitchen. During intermission after game 5, individually packaged potato chips will be available near the kitchen.

What is the minimum age of guests – Guests age 16 & up are welcome to play bingo.

What will bingo winners win – For games 1 through 9, winners will receive a fall plant and random \$25 gift card. Gift cards are donated, such as BP, Applebee's, Bob Evans, Amazon, Home Depot, Target, Walmart, Olive Garden, Circle K, and Ace. For the grand prize of game 10, the single winner will receive a \$50 Long Horn gift card and \$50 Fandango movie gift card and large fall plant.

Will raffle baskets be available – Yes, board members, volunteers and local businesses will donate great raffle baskets.

How much are raffle tickets – Raffle tickets are sold by the sheet; sheet of 25 tickets is \$20 each. Each sheet includes a chance to win a door prize.

What are the door prizes – We don't know yet. All door prizes are donated by the community. In the past, they have included trays of baklava, gift cards, candy, lotion & soaps, etc.

Will you offer a 50/50 drawing – Yes, each ticket is \$1 or 6 for \$5. March's event winner received \$357.

How will we raise funds – Everything, except dinner and hall rental is donated by the community, board members, volunteers and supporters. Admission ticket income, plus raffle ticket and 50/50 ticket sales minus expenses is the total profit.

What will be done with the profits – March's event raised about \$6,800 for the food pantry. The funds raised at this event will support the food pantry also. BACM serves over 3,300 people each month, taking home over 50,000 meals. Food is expensive!
