Our mission is to extend household resources in our communities through programs targeting food insecurity and basic need.

Our goal is to help low-income qualified residents of the community during a time of need by supplying emergency food, and other various social services. We work diligently to engage churches and others in the community to participate in outreach.

### 2024 YEAR END SERVICES AND PROGRAMS

# **Pantry**

Our relationship with the Akron Canton Regional Food Bank helps BACM with providing a five-day emergency supply of food provided to clients twice per month. We target families living in Barberton, Norton, Clinton, New Franklin, and Doylestown.

- Meals provided 613,041
- Food provided 276,830 lbs.
- Produce 30,323 pounds provided.
- Clients select pet food because we have a benefactor who provides support for pet food supplies.
- Between January and March, 509 households received Bags of Love.
- Churches and individuals donated 4,368 bags of groceries.

## **Cooking Classes**

The Ohio State University provided two (2) cooking classes in 2024.

# **Other Programs**

- Clients requesting assistance were given information for contacting Catholic Charities and other organizations for needs.
- BACM had 1,351 households assisted with services through BACM. Helping clients with applications for Medicaid/Medicare, First Energy, SNAP, HEAP, smoke detectors, senior classes at the YMCA, free and reduced lunch programs, Energy Conservation Services (refrigerators, freezers, lights, etc.) They assisted with Living Wills, Healthcare Powers of Attorney, and General Powers of Attorney.
- The Assurance Wireless information was given to clients for obtaining cellular phones.
- Clients have available brochures for agencies for referrals to various programs that are free.
- Provided delivery to 92 low-income seniors who participated in the CFSP program once a month. Total given out was 1,100.
- Clients had access to representatives for employment services and insurance.
- Pet Food Ministry BACM has one donor who generously sponsors our pet food ministry, and we also receive food from Norton Pet Supply Plus. Pets have food insecurities too.
- Pet Therapy Past board member Larry Okolish brings golden retriever, Finn, to visit clients on pantry days. Finn passed away this year.
- Home Food Deliveries Home deliveries are available to clients who are senior (ages 60 and over). BACM served 1,580 with home deliveries.
- Veteran's Counseling and Benefit Help with Bishop Edmond Fast Ph. D., Chaplain with The American Legion 566 and VFW 1066.
- Caption Call information made available to assist hearing impaired clients in receiving visual message phones.
