

BACM Bingo Frequently Asked Questions (updated 3/13/2026)

When is BACM Bingo – Wednesday, March 18, 2026

Where is BACM Bingo held – Prince of Peace Church, 1263 Shannon Ave, Barberton

What time can I attend – Doors will open at 4:30pm, not before 4:30pm

What time is dinner – Dinner is available from 5pm – 6pm. If you need to arrive after 6pm, ask a friend to prepare a to-go container for you. Leftovers are donated to Safe Harbor near 6:15pm.

What is for dinner – We will be ordering dinner from Leach’s Meats & Sweets catering Salisbury steak, mashed potatoes & gravy, vegetable medley of broccoli/cauliflower/carrots, tossed salad, roll & butter. Also, veggie lasagna is available for our non-meat eaters. When purchasing your admission ticket you must request lasagna, if you want it.

What is available to drink – Lemonade, ice tea, water and decaf coffee.

What time is bingo – 10 bingo games will begin near 6:15pm

What is the cost – \$30 per ticket. Admission ticket includes dinner & 10 games (3 boards per game) of bingo. Our new credit card processor, Zeffy requires no fees. You are welcome to donate to Zeffy, if you wish to.

When can I purchase a ticket – Fri. February 13 at 9am or until all 200 tickets are sold. SOLD OUT in 27 hours.

How can I purchase a ticket – Presale only tickets are available at www.bacm.org by credit or debit card.

How can I purchase a ticket if I don’t have internet service and/or credit card – If you have email, contact the Fundraising Committee at fundraiser@bacm.org. If no email, call or text Teri at 330-618-9571 to make other arrangements.

How many guests can attend BACM Bingo – Prince of Peace holds a maximum of 200 guests. We will pre-sale as many tickets as possible, with a maximum of 200.

How many tickets can I buy – Please limit your purchase to 16 tickets per buyer, to allow everyone the opportunity to buy tickets.

Is anything other than dinner served – Simple bite size desserts such as brownies & cookies will be on your table, along with Enchanted Café’s baklava. Also, gluten free Tate’s lemon & chocolate chips cookies will be available in the kitchen. During intermission after game 5, individually packaged chips will be available near the kitchen.

What will bingo winners win – For games 1 through 9, winners will receive a spring plant and random \$25 gift card. Gift cards are donated, including Applebee’s, Bob Evans, Cracker Barrel, Casa Del Mar, Clem’s Viral Bites, Tusk Diner, Sweet Henrie’s, JJ’s Norton Café, Olive Garden, Remarkable Diner, and Leach’s Meats & Sweet. For the grand prize of game 10, the single winner will receive a \$50 Olive Garden gift card and \$50 Fandango movie gift card and larger spring plant.

What is the minimum age of guests – Guests age 16 & up are welcome to play bingo.

Will raffle baskets be available – Yes, board members, volunteers and businesses have donated approx. 61 great raffle baskets.

How much are raffle tickets – Raffle tickets are sold by the sheet; sheet of 25 tickets is \$20 each. Each sheet includes a chance to win a door prize.

What are the door prizes – Enchanted Café had donated four \$25 café gift cards to be used as door prizes.

Will you offer a 50/50 drawing – Yes, each ticket will be \$5. The October's winner received \$550; half of the funds collected.

Will you have a Live Auction – Yes, the new live auction in October was a big success. The Cleveland Guardians and Cleveland Cavaliers have donated signed merchandise to auction off. This is a quick live auction of a couple items held after Game 5 before intermission.

How will we raise funds – Everything, except dinner is donated by the community, board members, volunteers and supporters. Admission ticket income, plus raffle ticket, 50/50 ticket sales, and live auction sales minus dinner cost is the total profit. Our goal this year is \$10,000!

What will be done with the profits – October's event raised \$9,582 for the food pantry. The funds raised at this event will help fill the pantry food shelves & freezers. So far, this year, BACM is serving about 2,600 people each month, taking home nearly 40,000 meals. The Akron Canton Regional Foodbank estimated that \$1 donated provides 3 meals.
