Washer Options

- Front Load Washer
 - Large capacity
 - Less water usage
 - Most units can be stacked
 - Option for a pedestal gives you extra storage
 - No agitator, extending the life of your clothes
- Top Load Washer
 - Easier access for loading and unloading
 - Largest capacity
 - Less expensive

Washer Considerations

- Capacity: You will need a large capacity washer if you washer bulky items, like comforters, or have a large family.
- Sound: Look for a machine with vibration reduction or added insulation if unit is located in or near a bedroom.
- Efficiency: Look for units with the Energy Star rating.
 Most front load washers have this rating and now some top load washers have it as well.
- Space and clearance: Make sure to measure the height, width and depth, taking into account clearances for hoses and door swings.
- Configuration: If you are limited on space, you may consider stacking a front load laundry set or going with a laundry center.
