We are very excited to continue the annual West Virginia Bigfoot Festival that brings thousands of visitors to our region. This year we will have limited RV and Tent camping spots available. (this is a separate application)

EVENT VENDOR PRODUCTS: This West Virginia Bigfoot Festival is open to vendors who are selling their own handmade crafts. Craft Vendors are not permitted to sell beverages, alcohol, tobacco products, or non-packaged food. Keep in mind that this is a family-friendly event, and thus, your items should be appropriate for children. (For example, if a 4-year-old or a local pastor shouldn't see it, we cannot permit it at the festival.)

SPACES: The space you are renting will be non-electric, and you will be required to bring your own table, chairs, and tent coverings. (You can bring a quiet generator for this new location) Each spot is 10 x 10, grassy, fairly level, and “as-is”. If your set up is larger than 10 x 10 you must apply and pay for more than one spot. You will receive your space assignment at the gate Friday morning when you arrive and present your vendor payment receipt which will be emailed to you upon application approval. Vendors spaces will be assigned by the committee. They are non-negotiable. (On rare occasions, we may have to change your spot number on your arrival, but we do our best to have everything mapped out ahead). On the day of the event, you may accept the spot assigned to you or you can choose to leave. You will receive two park passes for yourself and another person. If you bring more than that, they will need to pay the park entrance fee.

SET-UP: Friday set-up for vendors and will be from 8am - 2pm. Saturday at 8-9am

CLEAN-UP: When the event is over, tear-down will commence at 8 pm on Sunday. **Do not leave your trash.** Take all the boxes and trash with you. Everything must be removed by Sunday evening.

VENDOR and Staff CONDUCT: The Vendor is responsible for the conduct and dress of all its staff (employed or volunteering) and are required to continually man their booth during the festival. No foul language should be used during festival hours. No drug or alcohol use is allowed during the festival. The WV Bigfoot Coordinator retains the right to reject any staff that does not represent the Event's standards. All Client and Staff must be clothed and groomed in a clean, neat fashion and shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner.

Special Note: We do our very best to bring quality speakers and entertainment and we advertise hard before the event. We do our best to bring out a crowd. However, we cannot make people buy your products and are not liable for any lack of sales that you might have during the event. We also, cannot control the weather. This event is a rain or shine event.

*** Failure to comply with the West Virginia Bigfoot Festival rules will result in you not be considered for future events and your name will be given to other festival organizers. ***

APPLICATION AND PAYMENT: *Please return your application and payment as soon as possible to ensure proper processing. If your application is rejected, your money will be returned. A follow-up email with more instructions will be sent closer to the event. Without your email, you will not receive follow-up information.*
