Students should also expect to learn computer software programming that is up to industry standard while here in the Communication Media Department at Aims. HOST: Audio students learn audio production and editing programs like Adobe Audition, Pro Tools, and Music Instrument Digital Interface. HOST (V.O.): For our video students, we offer classes that work with industry-standard programs such as Adobe Premiere Pro, Avid Media Composer, Final Cut Pro, Adobe After Effects, and Cinema 4D. HOST: Students here have access to computer labs with editing programs to work on outside their classes.
