



Annual Medicaid Compliance Certifications **Certification Process Underway**

Every December, any Medicaid provider that is [required](#) to have a compliance program must submit a [certification](#) of compliance to the Office of the Medicaid Inspector General ([OMIG](#)). Providers should note that this year's form requires them to include their Provider ID and NPI. OMIG has provided information on the elements of an effective compliance program, as well as a [webinar](#) on completing the certification form.

Separately, providers that made or received at least [\\$5 million](#) in direct Medicaid payments in the federal fiscal year ending on September 30, 2018, must submit a [certification](#) of compliance with the Federal Deficit Reduction Act of 2005 on or before January 1, 2019.
