Boats have been brought in without BOD/ARC approval. A homeowner brought his boat in without approval. His truck was hooked up to the boat in his driveway. This homeowner has had numerous contacts with the board in the prior years for the same thing.

Motion made by Chris Steingrube, Treasurer to fine the homeowner \$50.00 for being in violation of the CC&R's. Motion seconded by Karen MacRae, Secretary. Motion passed.

Another homeowner brought his boat in without prior authorization from the HOA. The specific road was blocked with both boats. We are required to keep the roads clear for firetrucks and ambulances to get through.

Chris Steingrube, Treasurer made a motion to fine the homeowner \$50.00 for being in violation of the CC&R's. The homeowner previously received a fine late summer last year for the same thing. Motion seconded by Karen MacRae, Secretary. Motion passed.

Pass Cost of letters onto Property Owner after first mailing

Chris Steingrube treasurer, made a motion that after the first mailing of invoices/letters to the homeowner that the cost of mailing be added to the homeowner's invoice. Motion seconded by John Carmonne, member at large. A discussion was held. Motion passed.

How much to transfer from savings to CD

A discussion was held. Chris Steingrube made a motion not to transfer any moneys into the CD for now. Motion died.

Backyard Pools

Add 3.5% to transaction for taking payment via Credit Card.

We are required per the Maryland's Homeowners Association Act to charge homeowner's for the fee's to use credit cards to pay HOA Assessments.

Chris Steingrube, Treasurer made a motion that we charge homeowner's who use a credit card 3.5% to pay HOA assessments. Motion seconded by John Carmonne, Member at large. Motion carries.

Increase Sales Certificate charge to \$250.00 each

Chris Steingrube made a motion that we increase the resale certification charge from \$100.00 to \$250.00. Motion seconded by Paul Mills, Arc Chair. A discussion was held. Motion carries.

Paypal Fee's

Karen MacRae, Secretary made a motion that we pass along the PayPal fees of 2.9% plus a fee of .30 cents to the homeowners when using PayPal to pay their HOA assessments. Motion seconded by Chris Steingrube, treasurer. Motion carries.
