1. Introduction

Cut My Trees Please ("we," "our," or "us") is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you visit our website www.cutmytreesplease.com (the "Site") or use our tree services.

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. By using our Site or services, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, please do not use our Site or services.

2. Information We Collect

2.1 Personal Information You Provide

We collect personal information that you voluntarily provide to us when you:

- Request a quote or estimate

This information may include:

2.2 Information Automatically Collected

- Pages visited and time spent on pages
- Referring website addresses
- Date and time of access
- Geographic location (general region based on IP)

Cookies and Tracking Technologies:

- We use cookies, web beacons, and similar tracking technologies to collect information about your browsing activities
- Session cookies (temporary, deleted when you close browser)
- Persistent cookies (remain until deleted or expired)
- Analytics cookies to understand site usage
- Functional cookies to remember your preferences

2.3 Information from Third Parties

We may receive information about you from:

- Credit reporting agencies for payment verification
- Payment processors
- Marketing partners and advertising networks
- Social media platforms (if you interact with our social media)
- Public records for property information verification

2.4 Sensitive Information

We do not intentionally collect sensitive personal information such as:

- Social Security numbers
- Financial account numbers (beyond payment processing)
- Medical or health information
- Racial or ethnic origin
- Political opinions or religious beliefs

3. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect for the following purposes:

4. How We Share Your Information

We do not sell your personal information to third parties. We may share your information in the following circumstances:

4.1 Service Providers

We share information with third-party vendors who perform services on our behalf:

- Scheduling and dispatch software
- Accounting and bookkeeping services

4.2 Business Transfers

5.2 Types of Cookies We Use

Advertising Cookies: Deliver relevant advertisements and track campaign effectiveness

5.3 Managing Cookies

- Receive notifications when cookies are set

Note: Blocking cookies may impact Site functionality and prevent use of certain features.

5.4 Third-Party Cookies

We use third-party services that may set their own cookies:

- Other advertising and analytics platforms

These third parties have their own privacy policies governing their use of your information.

7. Data Security

7.1 Security Measures

- Secure payment processing (PCI-DSS compliant)

7.3 Data Breaches

In the event of a data breach affecting your personal information, we will notify you in accordance with applicable laws and take appropriate remedial action.

8. Data Retention

8.1 Retention Period

We retain your information for as long as necessary to:

- Fulfill the purposes described in this Privacy Policy
- Comply with legal, accounting, or reporting requirements
- Resolve disputes and enforce our agreements
- Maintain business records

8.2 Retention Guidelines

- Service records: Typically 7 years for accounting and legal purposes
- Marketing data: Until you unsubscribe or request deletion
- Website analytics: Typically 26 months (Google Analytics default)
- Payment information: As required by payment processors and financial regulations

8.3 Deletion

When information is no longer needed, we delete or anonymize it in accordance with our data retention policies and applicable laws.

9. Your Privacy Rights

9.6 Opt-Out of Marketing

- Unsubscribe from promotional emails via the unsubscribe link
- Opt out of text messages by replying STOP
- Contact us to be removed from marketing lists

9.7 Do Not Track

Currently, our Site does not respond to "Do Not Track" browser signals. You can manage cookies through your browser settings.

9.8 Exercising Your Rights

10. Children's Privacy
