



**Blue Ridge Community Theatre Presents:
High Country's Got Talent
Talent Show Guidelines/Rules**



To be Eligible:

- ❖ The show is open to any amateur Person/Group in the High Country
- ❖ Talents may include (but not limited to) singing, dancing, instrumental music, magic, storytelling, comedy, monologues, martial arts, juggling. Lip-syncing will not be allowed.
- ❖ Everyone must return a completed and signed Talent Show Participation Form.
- ❖ All who are part of a group act should submit their Participation Forms together.
- ❖ Recommended length is 3 minutes. Acts must be no more than 5 minutes including set up/strike.
- ❖ Maximum number of participants in an act is 8.
- ❖ In all cases, the decisions of the judges is final and will not be open to discussion.
- ❖ Absolutely no profanity or insensitive subject matter permitted.
- ❖ Costume must be appropriate for all age groups. This is a community event.
- ❖ Acts are responsible for the own props and costumes.

- ❖ All performances will be screened for appropriateness by the BRCT Board Members.
- ❖ NO PYROTECHNICS, SCIENCE EXPERIMENTS, NUDITY OR GLITTER IS ALLOWED.
- ❖ If your act requires recorded accompanying music, the music must be:
 Provided to the Talent show committee at the time of the auditions.
 The CD/Track must be labeled with your name and song name.
- ❖ **A Keyboard will be provided for audition/Performance if needed. Participants must have their own accompanist**

- ❖ It is the participant's responsibility to get the accompanying music back after the show
- ❖ Acts with any members under 18 must have written consent form parents for each member.
- ❖ Acts must be what is approved at the audition. No changes after the audition.
- ❖ There will be prizes given for 1st and 2nd place, and Honorable Mention.
