

Spring Semester Registration

TICKET INFORMATION

Get your recital tickets

Recital tickets sales start now! If you haven't purchased yours, make sure you head to the tickets site and grab yours.

How much do tickets cost?

Tickets are \$12 each with an additional tax and website fee.

Will there be door sales?

A limited number of tickets may be available for purchase at the door on recital day but are not guaranteed.

Do you offer a discount when buying tickets to multiple shows?

YES! When you are buying tickets for multiple shows, the online site will automatically discount. You must buy your tickets to multiple shows in one transaction or the discount will not be applied.

If there are ticketing issues, who do I contact?

You will contact Dance Recital Ticketing. Ticket purchasers are subject to their policies and guidelines so questions or concerns should be directed to (706) 550-1416

Can I exchange or return my tickets?

All ticket sales are FINAL and exchanges/refunds will not be given. Please make sure you buy tickets for the correct show. Utilize the dancer roster on the ticketing web page to determine the correct show for your performer.

Can I buy tickets at the front desk?

No, we do not sell tickets at the studio.

Can my dancer sit with me at the show?

No, all dancers will remain backstage for the entirety of the show and may be picked up after the show is over.

When are class photos?

Class photos will be taken during our spring semester dress rehearsal week.

When is Recital?

December 20th

Location: NNU Brandt Center Nampa Idaho

When does my dancer need to be at the recital?

Dancers must be checked into the Dancer Waiting Room no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of their show. The dancer check-in table will be open 1 hr minutes before each show for wristband pickup.

Please pick up upon arrival to avoid long lines.

Show #1 10:30 am: Dancer check-in 9:30-10:00am

Show #2 1:30 pm: Dancer check-in: 12:30-1:00pm

Show #3 4:30 pm: Dancer check-in 3:30-4:00pm

Show #4 7:30 pm: Dancer check-in 6:30-7:00pm

Where do we go when we enter the NNU Brandt Center?

Upon arrival, you will enter as if you are going into the theatre and walk up to the check-in table to pick up your dancer wristbands.

Should my dancer arrive in their costume with make up and hair done?

Yes, dancers should arrive ready to perform due to the limited space

Can my dancer bring whatever he/she wants backstage?

No, only garment bags are allowed backstage with a disposable water bottle. No big backpacks or toys.

HAIR & MAKEUP

Does my dancer need to wear makeup to the recital?

Yes! The lights on the stage are very bright and the theater is very large. All dancers will need to wear makeup for the Recital. This will make their beautiful faces stand out on stage and not be washed out by the lights. We recommend foundation, blush, classic red lipstick, mascara or false lashes, eye shadow in browns & eye liner.

How is the hair for the recital?

Hair is in a low pony with a middle part for ALL classes. If your dancer's hair is too short you can do half up half down with the same middle part.

PEAK WEEK DETAILS

Come see what your dancers have been working so hard on in their recreational classes. On the week of December 8th, come into the last 15 minutes of your dancers recreational classes to see what your dancer has been working on this season! *this doesn't apply for team or technique classes.


