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Class Rules:



- Please enter and exit through the front of the studio to avoid distracting classes in Studio 3.
- No phones or watches allowed in dance class.
- Please bring water and snacks to class.
- Keep fingernails trimmed and we ask dancers to put deodorant on for class.

Class Attire:

- Hair needs to be out of face in a poiny tail for every dance class.
- Hair needs to be in a bun for ballet class.
- Dancers must wear colored leotard (based on level), ballet tights and ballet shoes for ballet class.
- Dancers need to wear tight attire to acro class. No shoes are needed. Shocks are recommended for Acro 2-4.
- Hip Hop shoes (tennis shoes) are needed for hip hop class. Pants are recommended.
- Tap shoes are required for tap class
- Turners are required for all technique classes

Costume Fees:

On October 15th, you will be charged costume fees for all performing classes.

Ages 2-9 \$45.00

Ages 10-12 \$50.00

Ages 13+ \$55.00

Acro Classes \$40.00

Other important information:

- No parents are allowed inside dance classes.
- We will hold Peek Week once a semester where we invite parents in to come watch their dancers dance.
- If your dancer is in Acro please walk your dancer over to the Acro building or make sure they have a buddy to walk with.
- Competition parents please keep an eye out for cleaning videos posted on band weekly for your kids to review.
- Please check the lost and found often for your dancers things.
