

Cambridge Harbor Promenade Open to Public

The Promenade at Cambridge Harbor is now officially open to the public, marking the first completed public-facing element of the Cambridge Harbor redevelopment and a major milestone in reconnecting the community with the Choptank River waterfront.

The new promenade invites residents and visitors alike to walk along the river, relax in the green space, and enjoy sweeping waterfront views. Benches, tables, and chairs have been installed to encourage people to gather, linger, and experience the waterfront in a new way.

“The official opening of the Promenade reinforces our commitment to strong public access at Cambridge Harbor,” said CWDI President Angie Hengst. “We invite residents and visitors to enjoy the waterfront by walking along the promenade and relaxing on the benches overlooking the river. This amenity is for everyone in the community and we hope all will enjoy it for years to come.”



As part of a broader summer activation of the waterfront, Cambridge Waterfront Development, Inc. (CWDI) will host food trucks at Sailwinds Park at Cambridge Harbor on July 4 in conjunction with the community's fireworks celebration. CWDI will also hold an official ribbon-cutting ceremony and Business After Hours event, in partnership with the Dorchester Chamber of Commerce, for the opening of the Promenade on July 9 from 5:00 to 7:30 p.m. Food trucks will also be on site for the event.

Cambridge Harbor is the transformative waterfront redevelopment project along the Choptank River. The larger vision for it includes restaurants and retail, a boutique hotel, residential and mixed-use buildings, maritime and tourism amenities, and public gathering spaces designed to create a vibrant destination while maintaining public access to the waterfront.

CWDI is a nonprofit organization created through a partnership between the City of Cambridge, Dorchester County, and the State of Maryland to guide the redevelopment of Cambridge Harbor.
