 - Voter ID for absentee ballots
 - Drop Boxes can only be access during business hours and must be in a secure location
 - Election offices cannot receive grants from 3rd parties
 - Eliminated mobile voting
 - Once Ballots start getting counted by the counties they cannot stop until all ballots are counted
 - Just this Year, 3 new pieces of election integrity legislation were passed and signed into law
 - SB 189
 - Ballots are subject to open records request
 - Absentee ballots received before election day must be counted by 8pm
 - Increase sign off and sealing procedures for voting machines
 - SOS has to eliminate QR codes by 2026
 - Clears up the ability for challenges to voter rolls
 - HB 974
 - Ballots must have visible security Watermarks
 - Requires more risk limiting audits
 - HB1207
 - Allows Poll Watchers more access in voting locations
 - Provides more protections for Poll Watchers and Poll Workers
 - Requires election workers to be US citizens
