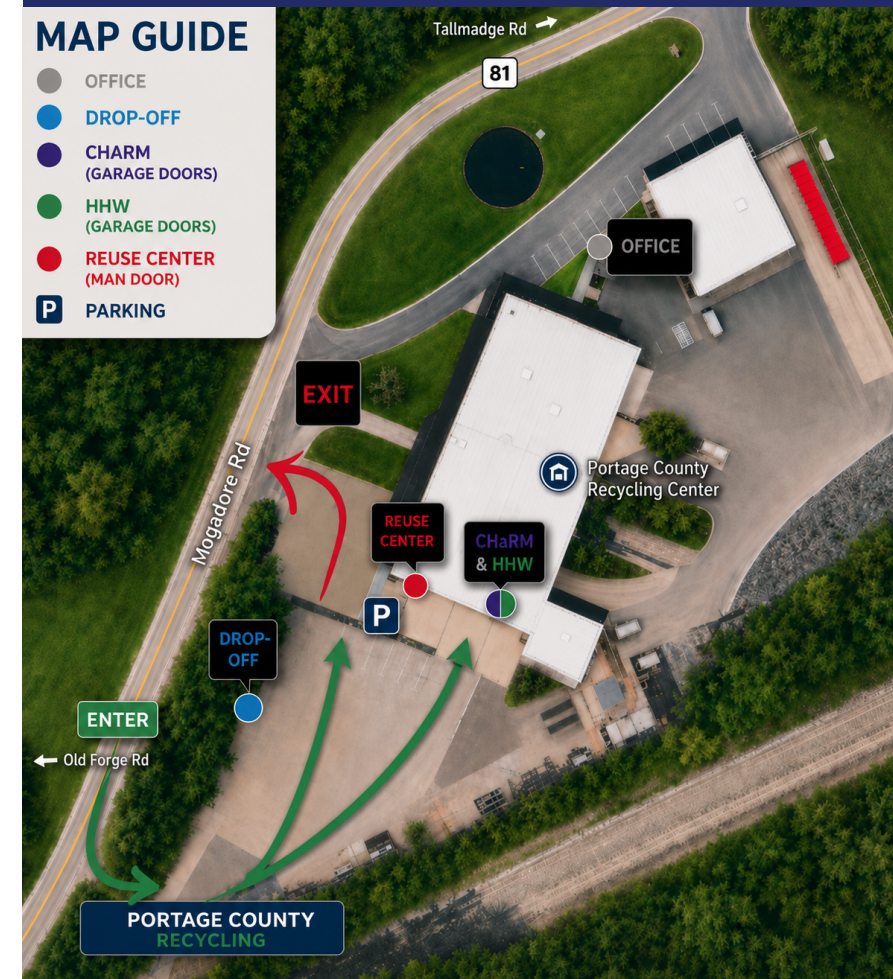

Appliances

PORTABLE/WINDOW AC
UNITS, COOKTOPS,

Scrap Metal

Ferrous and Non-ferrous metals, including wires, pipes, motors, parts, etc.



Plastic Bags

Plastic bags, film, ice bags, bubble wrap, etc.



Paper Shredding

REMOVE ALL BINDER CLIPS, PAPER CLIPS, RUBBER BANDS, FOLDERS AND ANY KIND OF BINDING



Cooking Oil

MUST be in a CLEARLY marked container with lid

REUSE CENTER

A place for Portage County residents to pick up useful items and give gently used things a second life.

Collection Guidelines

- ID Required
- Must read and sign risk waiver
- No businesses
- No smoking

How many items can we take?

3-4 items per household

Can we bring items back?

Yes, during our HHW event on the first Monday of every month between 2PM - 5PM.

Available Items

- Latex paint
- Oil-based paint & stains
- Spray paint
- Motor oil & automotive fluids
- Household cleaners
- Fertilizers
- Pool chemicals
- Adhesives & sealants
- Wood stains & finishes
- Aerosol products
- Lawn and garden products



WHEN?
Mondays OR Thursdays
10AM - 2PM

Items placed on the reuse shelf must meet all of the following requirements:

- Container is at least ½ full
- Label is intact, readable, and clearly identifies contents
- Product is in the original manufacturer's container
- Container is not damaged, leaking, or compromised and is relatively clean
- Product shows no signs of contamination or tampering

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

Clear rules to help people safely dispose of HHW

WHEN?
First Monday of the month
2PM - 5PM

- Portage County Residents **MUST provide ID**
- Residential waste only, NO BUSINESSES
- NO SMOKING
- Drive in, follow instructions and stay in your car
- No trailers

Acceptable Materials

- ACIDS
- ADHESIVES
- AEROSOL CANS
- FLUORESCENT LIGHTS
- FUEL
- HERBICIDES, PESTICIDES, INSECTICIDES, FERTILIZERS
- HOUSEHOLD CLEANERS
- MERCURY *MUST BE DOUBLE BAGGED* IF LIQUID MUST BE IN JAR
- OIL BASED PAINTS AND STAINS
- POOL CHEMICALS
- SOLVENTS

Unacceptable Materials

- WEAPONS • EXPLOSIVES
- CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS/DEBRIS
- RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS • STANDARD HOUSEHOLD TRASH • COMPRESSED GAS CYLINDERS • MEDICAL WASTE • PROPANE TANKS
- ASBESTOS
