The ASA Sailing Experience is almost here; we have 6 sessions scheduled for 2026.

Beginning sailors learn a huge volume in a very short time. Students' progress from never having seen a sailboat to sailing the boat themselves by the end of the sessions. Our experienced sailors will find the sessions worthwhile as well, helping shake the rust off. If you put your mind and effort into it, you will become a real "Sea Dog". The sessions will include Small Boat Sailing and Keelboat Sailing.

- Wed. June 10. *ASA Sailing Experience # 5 (5:00)
- Fri. June 12. *ASA Sailing Experience # 6 (5:00)

Here are a few things you should know immediately as you prepare for your adventure:

- You should arrive at 6:00 PM Friday for our first session, which will be the only classroom session. This session will be held in the Class-Room/Event Center at the Abilene Sailing Association.
- All other sessions will be held on the water on the dates and times listed above.
- If you would like to purchase souvenirs, please plan on bringing money with you, we will have a small trading post.
- Of course, T-shirts, Shorts and other comfortable non-swim wear clothes are needed.
- Lots of sunscreen and a good large brim hat.
- Sunglasses with Lanyard are recommended.
- Please bring all the personal care products you will need.
- A good water bottle is recommended (large mouth with loop).
- Bring a Great attitude and a willingness to learn.

The Sailing Experience Clinics will cost 50.00 Per/Person. (Youth Under 18 will need to be with a parent or designated guardian) The sessions are open to Members and Non-members.
