Daily Schedule of Camp Activities

Every day begins with a riding lesson. This is followed by a clinic covering a particular aspect of horse and stable management. Topics included safety in handling, proper grooming, saddling, care of tack and equipment, feeding and stall cleaning, horse care and first aid, etc. At the end of each session, family and friends are encouraged to come and watch their campers participate in an informal horse show. The show gives the campers a chance to demonstrate their skills they have learned and get the feel of a real horse competition. Campers bring their own lunch.
