Commissioner of Education Charlene Russell-Tucker and Governor Lamont recently announced an exciting new investment of American Rescue Plan Elementary and Secondary Schools Relief (ARP ESSER) funds: Voice4Change.

Voice4Change is investing more than \$1.5 million in **you!** You have the opportunity to submit a proposal to the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) outlining how you would spend \$20,000 at your school. All of the proposals from your school will then be placed on a ballot. In March, you'll vote on which proposal you want to see come to life!
