*****The Wright Bean at J.M. Wright Technical High School**. The Wright Bean was launched in March 2021 as part of the Hospitality, Tourism and Guest Services Trade. The Wright Bean beverage program provides our students with hands on experiential learning. This enables our students to simulate their own concepts and ideas while identifying consumer needs and developing marketing strategies. Furthermore, our production promotes entrepreneurship and empowerment to cultivate meaningful careers and experiences. In addition, our goal is to establish long term partnerships with small business owners, corporations, schools and leaders within the community as well as sponsorships when possible. Through a partnership with the CHC (Community Health Center), ALL WRIGHT TECH STUDENTS ages 16 and up are eligible to be vaccinated on May 1st at Lord & Taylor here in Stamford. Below is the link to sign up for the vaccination and a general vaccine information link.

CHC will be administering the Pfizer vaccine. CHC will welcome Wright Tech Seniors back for their second dose of the vaccine on May 16th and May 22nd. Students will come for their second dose at the same time as they were scheduled for their first dose. **The Pfizer vaccine is the only vaccine that is authorized for people between 16-17 years old**. This vaccine requires 21 days between the first and second dose.

***Please note that parents of students under 18 (16 and 17 year olds) will need to consent for their student to get vaccinated. They do not have to be present but they do need to sign the consent and have the student prepared to answer the pre-vaccination questions.
